## A Dead Church

Revelation 3:1-6

Revelation 3:1: And to the <u>angel</u> of the church in <u>Sardis</u> write, These things says <u>He who has</u> the <u>seven Spirits of God</u> (<u>sevenfold Spirit of God</u>) and the <u>seven stars</u>: <u>I know your works</u>, that you have a name that you are <u>alive</u>, but you are <u>dead</u>.

Isaiah 11:2: The Spirit of the (1) <u>Lord</u> shall rest upon Him, The Spirit of (2) <u>wisdom</u> and (3) <u>understanding</u>, The Spirit of (4) <u>counsel</u> and (5) <u>might</u>, The Spirit of (6) <u>knowledge</u> and of the (7) <u>fear of the Lord</u>.

These things says <u>He who has</u> the <u>seven Spirits of God</u>.

He has the seven stars. (Rev 1:20 "in my right hand")

"The **blood** of the **martyrs** is..."

You have a name that you are <u>alive</u>, but you are <u>dead</u>.

Ephesians 2:1-5: And you He made <u>alive</u>, who were <u>dead</u> in <u>trespasses</u> and <u>sins</u>, in which you <u>once walked according to the course of this world</u>, according to the <u>prince of the power of the air</u>, the spirit who now works in the sons of <u>disobedience</u>, among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were <u>by nature children of wrath</u>, just as the others. <u>But God</u>, who is <u>rich in mercy</u>, because of His <u>great love</u> with which He loved us, even when we were <u>dead</u> in trespasses, made us <u>alive</u> together with Christ (<u>by grace you have been saved</u>)

You have a <u>name</u> that you are <u>alive</u>, but you are <u>dead</u>.

"The world has yet to see what God can do <u>with</u>, and <u>for</u>, and <u>through</u>, and <u>in</u>, and by the man who is fully and wholly consecrated

to Him. By God's help, I will be that man." - Dwight Moody

**Revelation 3:2:** Be <u>watchful</u> (awake), and <u>strengthen</u> the things which remain, that are <u>ready to die</u>, for I have not found your works <u>perfect</u> before God.

Are you **awake** or are you **sleeping**?

It's not too late for you to wake up!

God wants you to wake up while there is still time!

Revelation 3:3: Remember therefore how you have received and heard; hold fast and repent. Therefore, if you will not watch (wake up), I will come upon you as a thief, and you will not know what hour I will come upon you.

Matthew 24:42-44: <u>Watch</u> therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming. But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched and not allowed his house to be broken into. Therefore <u>you</u> also be <u>ready</u>, for <u>the Son of Man is coming</u> at an hour you do not expect.

Revelation 3:4: You have <u>a few names</u> even in Sardis who have not <u>defiled</u> their <u>garments</u> (filthy, soiled, polluted); and they shall <u>walk with</u> <u>Me</u> in <u>white</u>, for they are <u>worthy</u>.

The <u>majority</u> in <u>Sardis</u> were <u>defiled</u>. (filthy, soiled, polluted)

Revelation 3:5: He who <u>overcomes</u> shall be <u>clothed in white garments</u>, and I will <u>not blot out his name</u> from <u>the Book of Life</u>; but I will <u>confess</u> his name before My Father and before His angels.

## Overcomer

- Dead in sin!
- <u>Slumber</u>
  - o **Eph. 5:14:** Therefore, He says: "<u>Awake</u>, you who <u>sleep.</u> <u>Arise</u> from the <u>dead</u>, and Christ will give you <u>light</u>."
- <u>Defiled</u> garments

## How can we **overcome**?

- By the **power** of **the Spirit of God**! Gal. 5:16, Rom. 8:11
- Holding fast (firm) to truth!
- Watching and living ready for Jesus's return!
- Repenting of defiled garments.

Revelation 3:5: He who <u>overcomes</u> shall be <u>clothed in white garments</u>, and I will <u>not blot out his name</u> from <u>the Book of Life</u>; but I will <u>confess</u> his name before My Father and before His angels.

Is it **possible** to have your name **blotted out** of **the Book of Life**?

Is <u>your</u> name written in the <u>Book of Life</u>?

1 John 5:11-13: And this is the testimony, that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life.

Revelation 3:5: And I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life; <u>but</u> I will <u>confess</u> his name <u>before My Father</u> and before His angels.

Matthew 10:32-33: Therefore, whoever <u>confesses</u> <u>Me</u> before <u>men</u>, him I will also <u>confess before My Father</u> who is in heaven. But whoever <u>denies</u> <u>Me</u> before men, him I will also <u>deny before My Father who is in heaven</u>.

**Revelation 3:6:** He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.
