Jesus Is Coming Again

Revelation 1:7-12

Revelation 1:1: The <u>Revelation</u> of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, which <u>God</u> <u>gave Him</u> to <u>show</u> His <u>servants</u> - things which must <u>shortly</u> take place. And He sent and signified it by His <u>angel</u> to His <u>servant</u> <u>John</u>. (1:1,4, 9; 22:8)

The <u>Revelation</u> (Greek - apokalupsis) of <u>Jesus Christ</u>: <u>Unveiled</u>, <u>uncovered</u> or <u>revealed</u>; something that was previously hidden but is now <u>clearly visible</u>!

Revelation 1:2-3: Who bore witness to the word of God, and to the testimony of Jesus Christ, to all things that he <u>saw</u>. <u>Blessed</u> is <u>he</u> who <u>reads</u> and <u>those</u> who <u>hear</u> the words of this prophecy, and <u>keep</u> (do, keep, take to heart) those things which are written in it; <u>for the time is near</u>.

Revelation 1:4: <u>John</u>, to the <u>seven churches</u> which are in Asia: Grace to you and peace from <u>Him who is and who was and who is to come</u> and from <u>the seven Spirits</u> (Sevenfold Spirit) who are before <u>His throne</u>.

Revelation 1:5: And from <u>Jesus Christ</u>, the <u>faithful</u> <u>witness</u>, the <u>firstborn from the dead</u>, and <u>the ruler over the kings of the</u> <u>earth</u>. <u>To Him</u> (be the glory) who <u>loved us</u> and <u>washed</u> (freed) <u>us</u> from our <u>sins</u> in <u>His own blood</u>.

Revelation 1:6: And has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Revelation 1:7: <u>Behold</u>, <u>He is coming</u> with <u>clouds</u>, and <u>every</u> <u>eye will see Him</u>, even <u>they who pierced Him</u>. And all the <u>tribes</u> of the earth will <u>mourn</u> because of Him. Even so, <u>amen</u>.

Zechariah 12:10: I will pour on the <u>house of David</u> and on the <u>inhabitants of Jerusalem</u> the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will <u>look on Me whom they pierced</u>. Yes, they will <u>mourn</u> for Him as one mourns for his only son, and <u>grieve</u> for Him as one grieves for a firstborn.

Jesus introduces Himself!

Revelation 1:8: "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the End," says the Lord, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."

Revelation 22:12-13: And behold, <u>I am coming quickly</u>, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work. <u>I am the Alpha and the Omega</u>, <u>the Beginning</u> and <u>the End</u>, the <u>First</u> and the <u>Last</u>."

(Isaiah 41:4)

Revelation 22:16: I, <u>Jesus</u>, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches. <u>I am</u> the <u>Root</u> and the <u>Offspring</u> of <u>David</u>, the <u>Bright</u> and <u>Morning Star</u>.

Revelation 22:17: And the <u>Spirit</u> and the <u>bride</u> say, "<u>Come</u>!" And let him who hears say, "<u>Come</u>!" And let him who <u>thirsts</u> <u>come</u>. <u>Whoever desires</u>, let him take the water of life <u>freely</u>.

Micah 5:2: But you, <u>Bethlehem</u>, though you are <u>little</u> among the thousands of Judah, yet out of you shall come forth to Me <u>the</u>

<u>One</u> to be <u>Ruler in Israel</u>, whose goings forth are from of old, <u>from everlasting</u>.

Almighty - the One who has His hands on everything!

It means Jesus has **sovereign** control over **everything**!

Revelation 1:9: I, <u>John</u>, both your <u>brother</u> and <u>companion in</u> <u>the tribulation</u> and <u>kingdom</u> and <u>patience</u> of Jesus Christ, was on the island that is called <u>Patmos</u> for <u>the word of God</u> and for <u>the testimony of Jesus Christ</u>.

<u>Tribulation</u> - affliction, distress, trouble, hardship, suffering, pressure, crushing weight

Revelation 1:10: I was in the Spirit on the Lord's Day, and I heard behind me a loud voice, as of a trumpet.

Revelation 1:11-12: Saying, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last," and, "What you see, write in a book and send it to the seven churches which are in Asia: to Ephesus, to Smyrna, to Pergamos, to Thyatira, to Sardis, to Philadelphia, and to Laodicea." Then I turned to see the voice that spoke with me.

Harpazo - carry off by force, snatched away, rescue from the danger of destruction
