## Ready For Jesus' Return Luke 12:35-41

**Luke 12:35:** "Let your <u>waist be girded</u> and your lamps burning;"

**Luke 12:35 (NIV):** Be <u>dressed ready for service</u> and keep your lamps burning,

Romans 12:6-8: Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith; or ministry, let us use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching; he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

**1 Peter 4:10:** As each one has received a gift, <u>minister it</u> to one another, as <u>good stewards</u> of the manifold grace of God.

**Ephesians 4:16:** from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the **effective working** by which **every part does its share**, causes **growth** of the body for the **edifying** of itself in love.

**Luke 12:35:** "Let your waist be girded and your <u>lamps</u> <u>burning</u>"

John 8:12: Jesus said <u>I am the light of the world</u>. He who <u>follows Me</u> shall not <u>walk</u> in <u>darkness</u>, but have the <u>light of life</u>.

Matthew 5:14-16: You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be <u>hidden</u>. Nor do they <u>light a lamp</u> and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. <u>Let your light so shine before men</u>, that they may see your <u>good works</u> and glorify your Father in heaven.

**John 5:35:** He (John) was the **burning and shining lamp**, and you were willing for a time to rejoice in his light.

Matthew 12:20: A <u>bruised reed</u> He will not break, and <u>smoking flax</u> He will not quench.

## Parable of the Returning Master

**Luke 12:35:** "Let your waist be girded and your lamps burning;

**Luke 12:36:** and you yourselves **be like men who WAIT for their master**, when he will **return** from the wedding, that when he comes and knocks they may **open** to him **immediately**.

**Luke 12:37:** <u>Blessed</u> are those <u>servants</u> whom the <u>master</u>, when he comes, will find <u>watching</u>. Assuredly, I say to you that he will <u>gird himself</u> and have them <u>sit</u> <u>down to eat</u>, and will <u>come and serve them</u>.

**Luke 12:38:** And if he should come in the <u>second watch</u> (9pm-12), or come in the <u>third watch</u>(12am - 3), and find them so, <u>blessed</u> are those servants.

Parable of the Thief in the Night

**Luke 12:39:** But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have **watched** and not allowed his house to be broken into.

**Luke 12:40:** Therefore **you** also **be READY**, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you **do not expect**.

- **Ready** for Jesus sudden return.

Matthew 25:1-10: "Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to <u>ten virgins</u> who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. Now five of them were <u>wise</u>, and five were <u>foolish</u>. Those who were foolish took their lamps and took <u>no oil</u> with them, but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. But while the bridegroom

was <u>delayed</u>, they all slumbered and slept. "And at midnight a cry was heard: 'Behold, the bridegroom is coming; go out to meet him!' Then all those virgins arose and trimmed their lamps. And the foolish said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' But the wise answered, saying, 'No, lest there should not be enough for us and you; but go rather to those who sell, and buy for yourselves.' And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came, and <u>those who were ready went in with him to the wedding</u>; and the <u>door was shut."</u>

Matthew 25:11-13: "Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open to us!' But he answered and said, 'Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you.' Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming."
