Luke 6:37-38

Luke 6:17: And He came down with them and stood on a **<u>level place</u>** with a crowd of His disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea and Jerusalem, and from the seacoast of Tyre and Sidon, who came to hear Him and be healed of their diseases

Luke 6:46: But why do you call Me Lord, Lord, and not <u>do</u> the things which <u>I say</u>?

Luke 6:27-36: "But <u>I say</u> to you who <u>hear</u>: <u>Love</u> your enemies, <u>do good</u> to those who hate you, <u>bless</u> those who curse you, and <u>pray</u> for those who spitefully use you (mistreat, hurt you). To him who strikes you on the one cheek, <u>offer the other also</u>. And from him who takes away your cloak, do not withhold your tunic either. <u>Give</u> to everyone who asks of you. And from him who takes away your goods do not ask them back. And just <u>as you</u> <u>want men to do to you</u>, you also <u>do to them</u> likewise. But if you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners love those who love them. And if you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners do the same. And if you lend to those from whom you hope to receive back, what credit is that to you? For even sinners lend to sinners to receive as much back. But <u>love</u> your enemies, <u>do good</u>, and <u>lend</u>, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High. For He is <u>kind</u> (gracious) to the unthankful and evil. Therefore be <u>merciful</u> (compassionate), just as your Father also is merciful.

Luke 6:37: <u>Judge not</u>, and you shall not be judged. <u>Condemn not</u>, and you shall not be condemned.

The opposite of **loving**, **good**, **blessing**, **praying**, **kind**, **merciful** person is a **judgmental** & **condemning** person. (Harsh, fault finding, critical, exacting, merciless)

Matthew 7:1-2: Judge not, that you be not judged.
2 For with what judgment you judge, you will be

judged; and with the <u>measure you use</u>, it will be <u>measured back to you.</u>

Luke 6:37: "Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. **Forgive**, and **you will be forgiven**.

Mark 11:25-26: Whenever you stand praying, if you have <u>anything</u> against <u>anyone</u>, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses. But <u>if you</u> <u>do not forgive</u>, <u>neither will your Father in heaven</u> <u>forgive your trespasses</u>.

Luke 6:38: <u>Give</u>, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you.
