The Romans Road

Romans 1:16: For I am **not ashamed** of the **gospel** of Christ, for it is the **power of God** to **salvation** for **everyone** who **believes**, for the **Jew** first and also for the **Greek**.

Luke 2:10-11: Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you <u>good</u> <u>tidings</u> of <u>great joy</u> which will be to <u>all people</u>. For there is born to you this day in the city of David a <u>Savior</u>, who is Christ the Lord.

John 4:42: "The Savior of World"

Romans 3:23: All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

John 3:16-18: For God <u>so loved</u> the <u>world</u> that He gave His only begotten Son, that <u>whoever believes</u> in Him should not perish but have <u>everlasting life</u>. For God did not send His Son into the world to <u>condemn the world</u>, but that the world through Him might be <u>saved</u>. He who <u>believes</u> in Him is <u>not</u> <u>condemned</u>; but he who <u>does not believe</u> is <u>condemned</u> <u>already</u>, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

Romans 6:23: For the <u>wages</u> of <u>sin</u> is <u>death</u>

- Spiritual death
- Physical death
- Second death

Matthew 12:36-37: But I say to you that for <u>every idle word</u> men may speak, they will <u>give account</u> of it in the <u>day of</u> <u>judgment</u>. For by <u>your words</u> you will be <u>justified</u>, and by your words you will be <u>condemned</u>.

Romans 5:8: <u>But God demonstrates</u> His own <u>love</u> toward us, in that while we were <u>still sinners</u>, Christ died <u>for us</u>.

Ephesians 2:4-5: <u>But God</u>, who is <u>rich in mercy</u>, because of <u>His great love</u> with which He <u>loved us</u>, even when we were <u>dead in trespasses</u>, made us <u>alive</u> together with Christ (by <u>grace</u> you have been <u>saved</u>).

Romans 6:23: For the wages of sin is death <u>but</u> the <u>free gift</u> of God is <u>eternal life</u> in <u>Christ Jesus</u> our <u>Lord</u>.

Romans 8:1: There is therefore now <u>no condemnation</u> to those who are <u>in Christ Jesus</u>, who do not <u>walk</u> according to the <u>flesh</u>, but according to the <u>Spirit</u>.

Matthew 12:31-32: Therefore I say to you, <u>every sin</u> and <u>blasphemy</u> will be <u>forgiven men</u>, but the <u>blasphemy against</u> <u>the Spirit will not be forgiven men</u>. It will not be forgiven him, either in <u>this age</u> or in the <u>age to come</u>.

Romans 8:11: But if <u>the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from</u> <u>the dead dwells in you</u>, He who raised Christ from the dead will also <u>give life to your mortal bodies</u> through His <u>Spirit who</u> <u>dwells in you</u>.

Romans 8:16-18: The <u>Spirit</u> Himself <u>bears witness</u> with <u>our</u> <u>spirit</u> that we are <u>children of God</u> and if children, then <u>heirs</u> -<u>heirs of God</u> and <u>joint heirs with Christ</u>, if indeed we <u>suffer</u> with Him, that we may also be <u>glorified</u> together. For I <u>consider</u> that the <u>sufferings of this present time</u> are <u>not worthy</u> to be compared with the <u>glory which shall be revealed in us</u>.

Romans 8:26: Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses

Romans 10:9-10: If you <u>confess</u> with <u>your mouth</u> the <u>Lord Jesus</u> and <u>believe</u> in your <u>heart</u> that <u>God has raised Him from the</u> <u>dead</u>, you will be <u>saved</u>. For with the <u>heart</u> one <u>believes</u> unto <u>righteousness</u>, and with the <u>mouth confession</u> is made unto <u>salvation</u>.

Romans 4:25: Jesus was <u>delivered</u> up because of our <u>offenses</u>, and was <u>raised</u> because of our <u>justification</u>.

Romans 12:1: I <u>appeal</u> to you therefore, brethren, and <u>beg</u> of you in view of <u>all</u> the <u>mercies of God</u>, to make a <u>decisive</u> <u>dedication</u> of your bodies [<u>presenting all your members and</u> <u>faculties</u>] as a living sacrifice, <u>holy</u> (devoted, consecrated) and <u>well pleasing</u> to God, which is your <u>reasonable</u> (rational, intelligent) worship.
