
A Pre-tribulation Rapture



1 Thessalonians 4:16-18: For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus, we shall always be with the Lord. Therefore comfort one another with these words.

English: caught up Greek: Harpazo

Latin: Rapturo

- Carry off by force
- Snatched away
- To rescue from the danger of destruction

The <u>Rapture</u> is a <u>distinct</u>, <u>separate</u> event from the <u>2nd Coming of</u> **Jesus** at the end of the Tribulation!

Rapture

- 1. The church meets Jesus in the air.
- 2. The <u>church</u> will be <u>taken home to heaven</u> by Jesus.
- 3. Jesus will come for His saints.
- 4. Only **believers** will **see** Jesus.

A Pre-tribulation Rapture

1. The Words of Jesus

Luke 17:34: I tell you, in that <u>night</u> there will be <u>two in one</u> bed: the <u>one</u> will be <u>taken</u> and the <u>other</u> will be <u>left</u>.

Luke 17:35-36: <u>Two women</u> will be grinding together: the <u>one</u> will be <u>taken</u> and the <u>other left</u>. <u>Two men</u> will be in the field: the <u>one</u> will be <u>taken</u> and the <u>other left</u>.

In <u>context</u>, the one that is <u>left</u> is the one that is facing <u>judgment</u> of God like the days of <u>Noah</u> and <u>Lot</u>!

Luke 21:36: <u>Watch</u> therefore, and <u>pray</u> always that you may be counted worthy to <u>escape</u> all <u>these things</u> (coming horrors) that will come to pass, and to <u>stand before the Son of Man</u>.

Revelation 3:10: Because you have kept My command to persevere, I also will keep you from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth.

2. The Imminent Return of Jesus

Jesus can return at any moment for His church!

Matthew 24:44: Therefore, you also <u>be ready</u>, for <u>the Son of Man is coming</u> at an hour you <u>do not expect</u>.

Matthew 25:13: Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour the Son of Man is coming.

Mark 13:32-37: But of that <u>day</u> and <u>hour no one knows</u>, not even the angels in heaven, <u>nor the Son</u>, but only the Father. <u>Take heed</u>, <u>watch</u> and <u>pray</u>; for you <u>do not know when the time is</u>. It is like a man going to a far country, who left his house and gave authority to his servants, and <u>to each his work</u>, and commanded the doorkeeper to <u>watch</u>. <u>Watch therefore</u>, for <u>you do not know when the master of the house is coming</u> - in the <u>evening</u>, at <u>midnight</u>, at the <u>crowing of the rooster</u>, or in the <u>morning</u> - lest, <u>coming suddenly</u>, he find you <u>sleeping</u>. And what I say to you, <u>I say to all</u>: <u>Watch!</u>

Titus 2:11-13: For the <u>grace of God</u> that brings <u>salvation</u> has appeared to <u>all men</u>, teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the <u>present age</u>, <u>looking for</u> the <u>blessed hope and</u> <u>glorious appearing</u> of our great <u>God</u> and <u>Savior</u> Jesus Christ.

Philippians 3:20-21: For our <u>citizenship is in heaven</u>, from which we also <u>eagerly wait</u> for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, who will <u>transform our lowly body that it may be</u> <u>conformed to His glorious body</u>, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself.

Hebrews 9:27-28: And as it is appointed for men to <u>die</u> <u>once</u>, but after this the <u>judgment</u>, so Christ was offered <u>once</u> to bear the sins of <u>many</u>. To those who <u>eagerly wait for Him</u> He will <u>appear a second time</u>, apart from sin, <u>for salvation</u>.

James 5:8-9: You also be <u>patient</u>. <u>Establish your hearts</u>, for the <u>coming of the Lord</u> is <u>at hand</u> (very near). Behold, the <u>Judge</u> is standing at the <u>door!</u>


2 Peter 3:9: The Lord is not <u>slack</u> concerning His <u>promise</u>, as some count slackness, but is <u>longsuffering</u> toward us, <u>not</u> <u>willing</u> that any should perish but that <u>all</u> should come to <u>repentance</u>.

The New Testament church

clearly lived in expectation that

Jesus' coming again was

imminent - at any moment!



3. The Wrath of God

- Revelation 6:17: The great day of <u>His wrath</u> has come...
- 11:18: The nations were angry, and Your wrath has come...
- 14:19: ... the great winepress of the wrath of God
- 15:1: ...the <u>wrath of God</u> is complete
- 16:1: Go and pour the bowls of the <u>wrath of God</u> on the earth
- 19:15: He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God

1 Thessalonians 1:9-10: How you <u>turned</u> to God from <u>idols</u> to serve the <u>living</u> and <u>true God</u>, and to <u>wait</u> for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, even <u>Jesus</u> who <u>delivers</u> (rescues) us from the wrath to come.

1 Thessalonians 5:9: For God <u>did not appoint us to wrath</u>, but to obtain <u>salvation</u> through our Lord Jesus Christ,
