
Around The Throne Of God

Revelation 4:3-6

Revelation 4:1 After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven. And the first (rank) voice which I heard was like a trumpet speaking with me, saying, "Come up here, and I will show you things which must take place after this.



Revelation 4:2: Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, a throne set in heaven, and One sat on the throne.

Revelation 4:3: And <u>He</u> who sat there was <u>like a jasper</u> (crystal clear) and a <u>sardius stone</u> (blood red) in appearance; and there was a <u>rainbow around the throne</u>, in appearance like an <u>emerald</u>.

Revelation 4:4: Around the throne were (1) twenty-four thrones, (3;21) and on the thrones I saw (2) twenty-four elders (12+12) (3) sitting, (4) clothed in white robes; and they had (5) crowns of gold on their heads.

Who are these 24 elders?

Revelation 5:9: And they <u>sang a new song</u>, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; For <u>You were slain</u>, and have <u>redeemed us</u> to God by <u>Your blood</u> out of <u>every tribe</u> and <u>tongue</u> and <u>people</u> and <u>nation</u>, 10 And have made <u>us kings</u> and <u>priests</u> to our God; And <u>we</u> shall <u>reign on the</u> earth."

Revelation 4:5: And <u>from the throne</u> proceeded <u>lightnings</u>, <u>thunderings</u>, and <u>voices</u>. <u>Seven lamps of fire were burning</u> <u>before the throne</u>, which are <u>the seven Spirits of God</u>. (Sevenfold Spirit) / Ch.1:4, 3:1, 4:5, 5:6)

Isaiah 11:2 The Spirit of the (1) <u>Lord</u> shall rest upon Him, The Spirit of (2) <u>wisdom</u> and (3) <u>understanding</u>, The Spirit of (4) <u>counsel</u> and (5) <u>might</u>, The Spirit of (6) <u>knowledge</u> and of the (7) fear of the Lord

There is an undeniable, powerful, connection between **prayer**, **coming boldly to the throne of grace**, and the **fire** of the **Holy Spirit**— **igniting** our lives!

Luke 3:21-22: When all the people were baptized, it came to pass that Jesus also was baptized; and (1) while He prayed, the (2) heaven was opened. And (3) the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and a (4) voice came from heaven which said, "You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased."

Luke 11:11-13: If a son asks for <u>bread</u> from <u>any father</u> among you, will he give him a <u>stone</u>? Or if he asks for a <u>fish</u>, will he give him a <u>serpent</u> instead of a fish? Or if he asks for an <u>eqq</u>, will he

offer him a <u>scorpion</u>? If you then, being <u>evil</u>, know how to give <u>good gifts</u> to your children, <u>how much more</u> will your <u>heavenly</u> <u>Father</u> give the <u>Holy Spirit</u> to those who <u>ask Him</u> (Keep, continue asking)!

Acts 1:14: These all with one mind were <u>continually devoting</u> <u>themselves to prayer</u>, along with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers.

Acts 4:31: And when they <u>prayed</u>, the place where they were <u>assembled together</u> was <u>shaken</u>; and they were <u>all filled with</u> <u>the Holy Spirit</u>, and they <u>spoke</u> the <u>Word of God</u> with <u>boldness</u>.

Revelation 4:6: <u>Before the throne</u> there was a <u>sea of glass</u>, like <u>crystal</u>. And in the midst of the throne, and <u>around the throne</u>, were <u>four living creatures</u>...

In ancient times— seas- spoke of turbulence, chaos, danger, evil, unrest!

This <u>sea of glass</u> like <u>crystal</u>— speaks of the <u>PERFECT PEACE</u> which is **found** before the **throne of God!**

Scripturally, there is an undeniable, powerful, connection between <u>prayer</u>, <u>coming boldly to the throne of grace</u>, and <u>PERFECT PEACE!</u>

John 14:27: <u>Peace I leave with you</u>, <u>My Peace I give to you</u>; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not (Stop) your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

John 16:33: These things I have spoken to you, that <u>in Me</u> you may have [perfect] <u>peace</u>. In the world you will have <u>tribulation</u>;

Isaiah 26:3: You will keep him in <u>perfect peace</u>, whose <u>mind is</u> stayed on You, because he <u>trusts</u> in You.

Philippians 4:6-7: Be <u>anxious</u> for <u>nothing</u>, but in <u>everything</u> by <u>prayer</u> and <u>supplication</u>, with <u>thanksgiving</u>, let your <u>requests</u> be made known to God; and the PEACE OF GOD, which <u>surpasses all understanding</u>, will <u>guard</u> your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Romans 5:1 Therefore, having been <u>justified by faith</u>, we have PEACE WITH GOD through our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u>.
