## Ready For Jesus' Return (Pt. 2) Luke 12:41-48

The Church **Ready** for **Jesus' Return** (Part 1)

- Not Worrying
- Not Fearful
- Not Greedy
- Not merely laying up <u>treasure on earth</u>.

Luke 12:35-40: "Let your <u>waist be girded</u> (ready for service) and your <u>lamps burning</u>; and you yourselves be like men who <u>wait</u> for their master, when he will return from the wedding, that when he comes and knocks they may open to him immediately. <u>Blessed</u> are those servants whom the master, when he comes, will find <u>watching</u>. Assuredly, I say to you that he will gird himself and have them sit down to eat, and will come and serve them. And if he should come in the second watch (9pm-12am), or come in the third watch (12-3am), and find them so, <u>blessed</u> are those servants. But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have <u>watched</u> and not allowed his house to be broken into. Therefore you also be <u>ready</u>, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect."

The Church Ready for Jesus' Return (verses 35-40)

- Serving
- Burning brightly in the darkness
- Waiting for our Master's return
- Watching and looking
- Blessed
- Ready: Are you <u>ready</u> Jesus' return?

**Luke 12:41:** Then Peter said to Him, "Lord, do You speak this parable **only to us**, or to **all people**?"

Mark 13:37: And what I say to you, I say to all: Watch!

**Luke 12:42-44:** And the Lord said, "Who then is that **faithful** and **wise steward**, whom his master will make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of food in due season? **Blessed** is that servant whom his master will find so **doing** when **he comes**. Truly, I say to you that he will make him **ruler over all that he has**."

The Church **Ready** for **Jesus' Return** (verses 42-44)

- Faithful trustworthy, reliable
- Wise
- **Stewards** overseeing ministry
- Doing when <u>He comes</u>
- Blessed: as we <u>faithfully</u> and <u>wisely</u> serve in the little it leads to <u>more</u>

The Church that is **Not Ready** for **Jesus' Return** (verses 45-48)

Luke 12:45-48: But if that servant says in his heart, "My master is delaying his coming," and begins to beat the male and female servants, and to eat and drink and be drunk, the master of that servant will come on a day when he is not looking for him, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in two and appoint him his portion with the unbelievers. And that servant who knew his master's will, and did not prepare himself or do according to his will, shall be beaten with many stripes. But he who did not know, yet committed things deserving of stripes, shall be beaten with few. For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required; and to whom much has been committed, of him they will ask the more.

The Church that is **Not Ready** for **Jesus' Return** (verses 45-48)

- My Master is delaying in His coming
- Not looking, not aware of Jesus' return
- **Beat** his fellow servants. (Anger, Abuse)
- Eating, drinking and drunk

Galatians 5:19-21: Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, <u>drunkenness</u>, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who <u>practice</u> such things will <u>not</u> inherit the <u>kingdom of God</u>.

The Church that is **Not Ready** for **Jesus' Return** (verses 45-48)

- His portion (end) will be with unbelievers
- Knows but is **not prepared** for Jesus return
- Knows but doesn't do Jesus' will in His absence
- **Don't know** about **Jesus**, His **will** or **return**
- Judged with unbelievers: many / few stripes
- <u>Don't know</u> that to whom <u>much is given</u>, from him <u>much will be required</u>
