

## Hear Him

Luke 9:27-36

**Luke 9:23-26:** Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it. For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and is himself destroyed or lost? For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words, of him the Son of Man will be ashamed when He comes in His own glory, and in His Father's, and of the holy angels."

**Luke 9:27:** "But I tell you truly, there are some standing here who shall not taste death (die) till they see the kingdom of God."

**Luke 9:28:** Now it came to pass, about eight days after these sayings, that He took Peter, John, and James and went up on the mountain to pray.

**Luke 9:29:** As He prayed, the appearance of His face was altered, and His robe became white and glistening.

**Matthew 17:1-2:** Jesus took Peter, James, and John up on a high mountain by themselves; and He was transfigured (transformed) before them. His face

shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as the light.

Jesus' **deity** began to shine through His **humanity**!

**Luke 9:30:** And behold, two men talked with Him, who were **Moses** and **Elijah**,

**Luke 9:31:** who appeared in **glory** and spoke of His **decease** (Greek - **Exodus**) which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem.

**Luke 9:32:** But Peter and those with him were **heavy with sleep**; and when they were fully awake, they saw **His glory** and the **two men** who stood with Him.

**Luke 9:33** Then it happened, as they were parting from Him, that Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is **good for us to be here**; and let us make three tabernacles: one for **You**, one for **Moses**, and one for **Elijah**" - **not knowing what he said**.

**Luke 9:34-35:** While he was saying this, a **cloud** came and overshadowed them; and they were **fearful** as they entered the **cloud**. And a voice came out of the **cloud**, saying, "**This is My beloved Son** (in whom I am **well pleased** - Mt. 17:5) **Hear Him!**"

**Deuteronomy 18:9-14:** When you come into the land which the Lord your God is giving you, you shall not learn to follow the abominations of those nations. There shall not be found among you anyone who makes his son or his daughter pass through the fire, or one who practices witchcraft, or a soothsayer, or one who interprets omens, or a sorcerer, or one who conjures spells, or a medium, or a spiritist, or one who calls up the dead. For all who do these things are an abomination to the Lord, and because of these abominations the Lord your God drives them out from before you. You shall be blameless before the Lord your God. For these nations which you will dispossess listened to soothsayers and diviners; but as for you, the Lord your God has not appointed such for you.

**Deuteronomy 18:15:** The Lord your God will raise up for you a **Prophet like me** from your midst, from your brethren. **Him you shall hear!**

**Luke 9:35:** And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, **"This is My beloved Son. Hear Him!"**

**Luke 9:36:** When the voice had ceased, **Jesus was found alone**. But they kept quiet, and told no one in those days any of the things they had seen.

**2 Peter 1:16-19:** For we did not follow **cunningly devised fables** when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were **eyewitnesses** of **His majesty**. For He received from God the Father honor and glory when such a voice came to Him from the Excellent Glory: "**This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.**" And we heard this voice which came from heaven when we were with Him on the holy mountain. We have also **a more sure word of prophecy**, which you do well to heed as **a light that shines in a dark place**, until the **day dawns** and the **morning star** rises in your **hearts**.
