Luke 19:28-44

The Week That Changed The World

Luke 19:28: When He had said this, He went on ahead, **going up to Jerusalem.**

Luke 19:29: And it came to pass, when He drew near to Bethphage and Bethany, at the **mountain called Olivet,** (**Mount of Olives**) that He sent two of His disciples,

Luke 19:29-30: And it came to pass, when He drew near to Bethphage and Bethany, at the **mountain called Olivet,** that He sent **two** of His **disciples,** saying, "Go into the village opposite you, where as you enter you will find a **colt** tied, on which no one has ever sat. Loose it and bring it here."

Zechariah 9:9: **Rejoice greatly,** oh daughter of Zion! **Shout,** oh daughter of **Jerusalem!** Behold, your **King** is coming to **you;** He is **just** and having **salvation,** **lowly** and riding on a donkey, a **colt,** the **foal** of a **donkey.**

In His 1st coming: Jesus came **lowly,** riding a donkey; **just** and having **salvation;** He came to make **Peace.**

At His 2nd coming: Jesus is coming in glory; riding on a white horse (Rev. 19); He's coming to make War.

Jesus is going to return to the Mount of Olives.

Zechariah 14:4, 9: And in that day His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, which faces Jerusalem on the east. And the Lord shall be King over all the earth.

Luke 19:35-36: Then they brought him to Jesus. And they threw their own clothes on the colt, and they set Jesus on him. And as He went, many spread their clothes on the road.

Luke 19:37-38: Then, as He was now drawing near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works they had seen, saying: "**Blessed** is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"

Matthew 21:9: Hosanna (save now) to the Son of David! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!

Psalm 118:24-26: This is the day the Lord has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it. Save now, I pray, oh Lord; oh Lord, I pray, send now prosperity. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!

Luke 19:38: saying: "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"

Luke 2:14: Glory to God in the highest and on earth peace.

Luke 19:38: Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!

Luke 19:39: And some of the Pharisees called to Him from the crowd, "Teacher, rebuke Your disciples."

Luke 19:40: But He answered and said to them, "I tell you that if these should keep silent, the stones would immediately cry out."

Luke 19:41: Now as He drew near, He saw the city and wept over it.

John 1:11: He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him.

Matthew 23:37: Oh Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the one who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her! How **often I wanted** to gather your children together, as a **hen** gathers her chicks under her wings, but **you were not willing!**

Luke 19:42: saying, "If you had known, even you, **especially** in this **your day**, the things that make for your **peace!** But now they are **hidden from your eyes.**"

Daniel 9:25: One of the greatest prophecies in the Bible.

Jesus expected the Jewish people to **understand the times** that they were living in!

Luke 19:43-44: For days will come upon you when your **enemies** will build an **embankment around you**, **surround you** and **close you in on every side**, and **level you**, and your children within you, to the ground; and they will **not leave in you one stone upon another**, because you did not know the **time of your visitation.**

Tragically, Israel **missed** the **day** that the Lord had for them.

They **missed out** on the **peace** He came to bring!

He was **visiting** them but they didn't **know** it!

He was wanting to gather them **as a hen gathers her chicks** but they were **unwilling!**

Are you at **PEACE** with God?

Jesus came **just** and having **salvation**.
Are you SAVED?

Daniel 9:26: **Messiah** shall be **cut off** - but **not for Himself!**

John 1:11-12: He came to His own, and **His own did not receive Him**. **But** as many as **received Him**, to them He gave the right to become **children of God**, to those who **believe in His name**.
