## Tell What Great Things Jesus Has Done Luke 8:27-39

Luke 8:26: Then they <u>sailed</u> to the <u>country of the</u> <u>Gadarenes</u>, which is opposite Galilee.

Luke 8:27: And when He stepped out on the land, there <u>met Him a certain man</u> from <u>the city</u> who had <u>demons</u> for a <u>long time.</u> And he wore <u>no clothes</u>, nor did he live in a <u>house</u> but in the <u>tombs.</u>

Luke 8:28: When he saw Jesus, he cried out, <u>fell down</u> <u>before Him</u>, and with a loud voice said, "What have I to do with You, <u>Jesus, Son of the Most High God!</u> I beg You, do not <u>torment me</u>!"

**Luke 8:29:** For He had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For it had often seized him, and he was kept **under guard**, bound with **chains** and **shackles**; and he **broke the bonds** and was **driven** by the demon into the **wilderness** 

**Luke 8:30:** Jesus asked him, saying, "What is your name?" And he said, "**Legion**," because many demons had entered him.

Luke 8:31: And they begged Him that <u>He would not</u> command them to go out into the <u>abyss</u>.

Luke 8:32: Now a <u>herd of many swine</u> was feeding there on the mountain. So they begged Him that <u>He would</u> <u>permit them</u> to enter them. And <u>He permitted them</u>.

Luke 8:33: Then the demons went out of the man and entered the swine, and the herd ran <u>violently</u> down <u>the</u> <u>steep place</u> into the lake and <u>drowned</u>.

Luke 8:34-25: When those who <u>fed them</u> saw what had happened, they fled and told it in the city and in the country. Then they went out to see what had happened, and came to Jesus, and found the man from whom the demons had departed, <u>sitting at the feet of Jesus</u>, <u>clothed</u> and in <u>his right mind</u>. And they were afraid.

Luke 8:36: They also who had seen it told them by what means he who had been demon-possessed was <u>healed.</u>

Luke 8:37: Then the whole multitude of the surrounding region of the Gadarenes <u>asked Him to depart from</u> <u>them</u>, for they were seized with great <u>fear</u>. And He got into the boat and returned. Luke 8:38: Now the man from whom the demons had departed begged Him that he might <u>be with Him</u>. But Jesus sent him away, saying,

Luke 8:39: "<u>Return</u> to your <u>own house</u>, and <u>tell what</u> <u>great things God has done for you.</u>" And he went his way and proclaimed throughout the <u>whole city</u> what <u>great things Jesus had done for him.</u>

- Hopeless (hopeless situation)
- Naked
- Homeless
- Driven by the demonic —> wilderness (isolated)
- Lived among theTombs (dead)
- Cutting outward behavior
- Fierce- animal like
- Bound
- Crying out day and night
- No one could pass by
- Runs to Jesus, Worships
- Falls down before Him
- Sitting at feet of Jesus > < driven wilderness, isolated
- Clothed (Isaiah 64:6)
- Right mind
- Healed (saved, whole) No longer Cutting... Bound!
- He wanted to **be with Jesus**

- **Restored** to his family,
- Telling- family, friends, whole city, Decapolis (more) Great things!! (No longer in the way-> pointing to the WAY!)
