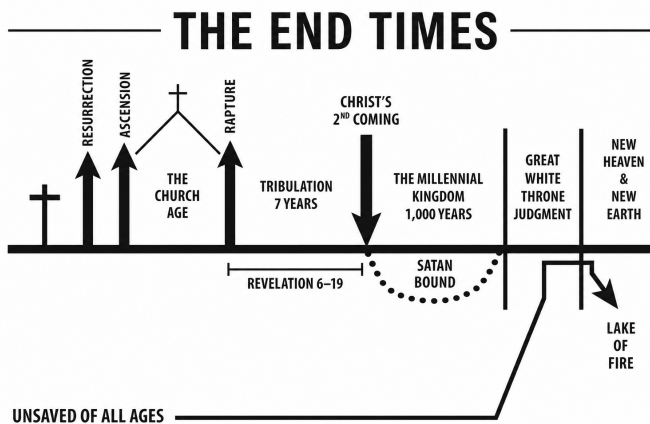


## All Things New in Jesus Revelation 21:1-8



Revelation 21:1: Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away (20:11). Also there was no more sea.

Isaiah 65:17: For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth; the former shall not be remembered or come to mind.

1 John 2:15-17: Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world - the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life - is not of the Father but is of the world. And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.

2 Peter 3:10-13: But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; (Colossians 1:17) both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up. Therefore, since all these things will be dissolved, what manner of persons ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness, looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat? Nevertheless we, according to His promise (Isaiah 65:17), look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

**Revelation 21:2:** Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

**Revelation 21:3:** And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God."

**Revelation 21:4:** And God will •wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be •no more death, •nor sorrow, •nor crying. There shall be •no more pain, for the former things have passed away.

**Revelation 21:5:** Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful."

## 1. A **NEW** BIRTH

**John 3:3–7:** Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. Do not marvel that I said to you, "You must be born again."

**Ezekiel 36:26–27:** And I will give you a new heart, and I will put a new spirit in you. I will take out your stony, stubborn heart and give you a tender, responsive heart. I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments.

### 3. A NEW CREATION; A NEW BEGINNING

2 Corinthians 5:17: Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

### 4. A NEW COVENANT

Luke 22:20: Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you."

### 5. A NEW COMMANDMENT

John 13:34: A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

### 6. A NEW SONG

Revelation 5:9–10: And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy. For You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, and have made us kings and priests to our God; and we shall reign on the earth."

### 7. A NEW NAME

Revelation 2:17: To him who overcomes I will give a new name written which no one knows except him who receives it.

Revelation 21:5: Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful."

Revelation 21:6: And He said to me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts."

Are you thirsty?

Revelation 22:17: And the Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely.

Overcomers— (nikaō) knee - kah - oh

Revelation 21:8: But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.

Revelation 2:11: He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. He who overcomes shall not be hurt by the second death.
