## Jesus •Called •Gave •Sent •Said Luke 9:1-6

Luke 9:1: Then He called His twelve disciples together

Luke 9:23-26: If <u>anyone</u> desires to come after Me, let him <u>deny himself</u>, and <u>take up his cross daily</u>, and <u>follow Me</u>. For whoever desires to <u>save</u> his life will <u>lose</u> it, but whoever <u>loses</u> his life for My sake will <u>save</u> it. For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and is himself <u>destroyed</u> or <u>lost</u>? For whoever is <u>ashamed</u> of <u>Me and My words</u>, of him the Son of Man will be ashamed when He comes in His own glory, and in His Father's, and of the holy angels.

**Luke 9:1:** Then He <u>called</u> His twelve disciples together and <u>gave</u> them <u>power</u> and <u>authority</u> over <u>all demons</u>, and to <u>cure diseases</u>.

Mark 6:12-13: So they went out and preached that people should repent. And they cast out many demons, and <u>anointed with oil</u> many who were <u>sick</u>, and <u>healed</u> them.

James 5:14-15: Is anyone among you <u>sick</u>? Let <u>him</u> call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, <u>anointing him with oil</u> in the name of the Lord. And the

<u>prayer of faith</u> will save the <u>sick</u>, and the Lord will <u>raise</u> <u>him up</u>.

- 2 Corinthians 12:8-10: Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong.
- **Luke 9:2:** He <u>sent</u> them to <u>preach</u> the <u>kingdom of God</u> and to <u>heal the sick</u>.
- **Luke 9:3** And He <u>said</u> to them, "Take nothing for the journey, neither staffs nor bag nor bread nor money; and do not have two tunics apiece."
- **Luke 9:4-5:** "Whatever <u>house</u> you enter, stay there, and from there depart. And whoever will not receive you, when you go out of that city, <u>shake off the very dust</u> <u>from your feet</u> as a testimony against them."
- **Luke 9:6:** So they departed and went through the towns, preaching the **gospel** and **healing everywhere**.
