Revelation 4:11

Revelation 4:8: The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!"

Revelation 4:9: Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever,

Revelation 4:10: The twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying:

Revelation 4:11: You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, and for your will they are and were created.

Revelation 4:11 (KJV): You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, and for your pleasure they are and were created.

One of the central purposes for why you exist is to bring God pleasure!

Jesus is our example!

Matthew 3:17: This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

Matthew 17:5: This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. Hear Him!

In Christ

Romans 8:8: So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

- Justification - (one time)
- Sanctification - (The work of a lifetime!)

Have you been justified?

John 8:29: I always do those things that please Him.

2 Corinthians 5:9-10: Therefore we make it our aim, whether present or absent, to be well pleasing to Him. For we must all appear before the judgment (Bema) seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

Colossians 1:10: That you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, fruitful in every good work.

1 Thessalonians 2:4: ...we speak, not as pleasing men, but God who tests our hearts.

1 Thessalonians 4:1: Finally then, brethren, we urge and exhort in the Lord Jesus that you should abound more and more, just as you received from us how you ought to walk and to please God.

Philippians 2:12-13: Work out (sanctification) your own salvation with fear and trembling; for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure.

Revelation 3:19: As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and repent.

1 John 1:7: But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

1 John 1:9: If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (Proverbs 28:13)

James 5:16: Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The heartfelt continued prayer of a righteous man makes tremendous power available.

1 Corinthians 11:31: If we would judge ourselves, we would not be judged. (Chastened by God)

Matthew 5:23-24: Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

Hebrews 11:5: By faith Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death, and was not found, because God had taken him; for before he was taken he had this testimony, that he pleased God. (Gen 5:24)

Hebrews 13:15-16: Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of (1) praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name. But do not forget (2) to do good and (3) to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

Hebrews 13:20-21: Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.
