A Faithful Church Revelation 3:7-13

Revelation 3:7: And to the <u>angel</u> of the church in <u>Philadelphia</u> write, 'These things says <u>He who is holy</u>, He who is <u>true</u> (not fake / counterfeits), "He who has the <u>key of David</u>, He who <u>opens and no one shuts</u>, and <u>shuts and no one opens"</u>:

Revelation 1:18: <u>I am He who lives</u>, and was <u>dead</u>, and <u>behold</u>, <u>I am alive forevermore</u>. <u>Amen</u>. And <u>I have the keys of Hades and of Death</u>.

2 Corinthians 5:8: To be <u>absent</u> from the <u>body</u> is to be <u>present</u> with the <u>Lord</u>!

To be <u>absent</u> from the <u>body</u> is to be incarcerated behind the bars of <u>hades</u> (hell).

He who has the <u>key of David</u>, He who <u>opens and no</u> <u>one shuts</u>, and <u>shuts and no one opens</u>:

Revelation 3:8: "I know your works. See, (1) I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it;

1 Corinthians 16:9: For a <u>great</u> and <u>effective</u> <u>door</u> has <u>opened to me</u>, and there are many <u>adversaries</u>.

Revelation 4:1: After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven and the first voice which I heard was like a trumpet speaking with me, saying, "Come up here!..."

Revelation 3:8: I know your works. See, I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it; for (2) <u>you have</u> a <u>little strength</u>, have (3) <u>kept My word</u>, and have (4) <u>not denied My name</u>.

Revelation 3:9: Indeed I will make those of the <u>synagogue</u> of <u>Satan</u>, who say they are Jews and are not, but lie - indeed I will make them come and <u>worship before your</u> <u>feet</u>, and to <u>know that I have loved you</u>.

Revelation 3:10: Because you <u>have kept</u> My command to <u>persevere</u>, I also <u>will keep you from</u> (out of) the <u>hour of trial</u> which shall come upon the <u>whole world</u>, to <u>test</u> those who <u>dwell on the earth</u>. (17:8)

The promises of Jesus

Luke 21:36: <u>Watch</u> therefore, and <u>pray</u> always that you may be counted worthy to <u>escape</u> all <u>these things</u> (coming judgement) that will come to pass, and to <u>stand before the Son of Man</u>.

Revelation 3:10: Because you have kept My command to persevere, I also will keep you from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth.

Revelation 3:11: <u>Behold</u>, <u>I am coming quickly</u>! <u>Hold fast</u> (firm) <u>what you have</u>, that no one may take your <u>crown</u>.

- A church of open doors
- Ministering in <u>little</u> strength
- Being a <u>doer</u> of the <u>Word</u>
- Not <u>denying</u> the <u>name</u> of <u>Jesus</u>.

Revelation 3:12: He who <u>overcomes</u>, I will make him a <u>pillar</u> in the temple of My God, and <u>he shall go out no more</u>. <u>I will write on him the name of My God</u> and <u>the name of the city of My God</u>, the <u>New Jerusalem</u>, which comes down out of heaven from My God. And <u>I will write on him My new name</u>.

<u>Pillar</u> - strength, stability, immovable, beauty, weight-bearing!

My new name

A <u>new</u> Covenant, a <u>new</u> creation, a <u>new</u> beginning!

A <u>new</u> heart, a <u>new</u> spirit! <u>Newness</u> of life! <u>New</u> speech (out of heart the mouth speaks) <u>New</u> identity in Christ!

Jesus gives us <u>a new name</u>!

What are some of <u>names</u> that the <u>world</u> places on us?

What are some of **names** that **Jesus** places on us?

What's my new name?

Revelation 3:13: He who has an <u>ear</u>, let him <u>hear</u> what the <u>Spirit</u> says to the <u>churches</u>.
