## The Most Important Question Ever Asked Luke 9:18-22

**Luke 9:18:** And it happened, as He was alone **praying**, that His disciples joined Him, and He asked them, saying, "Who do the crowds say that I am?"

- In trouble?
- Infrequently?
- Daily?
- Without Ceasing?

**Luke 3:21-22:** It came to pass that Jesus also was baptized; and while He prayed, the • heaven was opened. And the • Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and a • voice came from heaven which said, "You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased."

**Luke 5:16:** So He Himself <u>often</u> <u>withdrew</u> into the wilderness and <u>prayed</u>.

- The <u>demand</u> pushed Jesus <u>to prayer</u>, NOT from <u>prayer</u>.
- <u>Prayer</u> is connected to the <u>power</u> of God in our lives!
- Prayer links our soul to OMNIPOTENT God!

**Luke 6:12:** Now it came to pass in **those days** that He went out to the mountain to **pray**, and continued **all night in prayer to God**.

**Luke 9:18:** And it happened, as He was alone **praying**, that His disciples joined Him, and He asked them, saying, "Who do the crowds say that I am?"

Luke 9:19: So they answered and said, "John the Baptist, but some say Elijah; and others say that one of the old prophets (Jeremiah) has risen again."

Luke 9:20: He said to them, "But who do YOU say that I am?" Peter answered and said, "The Christ (Messiah) of God."

Matthew 16:17-18: Jesus answered and said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My Father who is in heaven. And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it."

Luke 9:21-22: And He strictly warned and <u>commanded</u> them to <u>tell this to no one</u>, saying, "The <u>Son of Man</u>

MUST <u>suffer</u> many things, and be <u>rejected</u> by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be <u>killed</u>, and be <u>raised</u> the third day."

**1 Peter 4:19:** Therefore let those who <u>suffer</u> according to the <u>will of God</u> commit their souls to Him in doing good, as to a <u>faithful Creator</u>.

**Romans 4:25:** who was <u>delivered</u> up because of our <u>offenses</u>, and was <u>raised</u> because of our <u>justification</u>.
