

Jerusalem Trampled

Luke 21:24-27

Luke 21:5-7: Then, as some spoke of the temple, how it was adorned with beautiful stones and donations, He said, "These things which you see - the days will come in which not one stone shall be left upon another that shall not be thrown down." So they asked Him, saying, "Teacher, but when will these things be? And what sign will there be when these things are about to take place?"

Luke 21:20-24: "But when you see Jerusalem surrounded by armies, then know that its desolation is near. Then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains, let those who are in the midst of her depart, and let not those who are in the country enter her. For these are the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled. But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! For there will be great distress in the land and wrath upon this people. And they will fall by the edge of the sword (1.1 million), and be led away captive (97,000) into all nations. And Jerusalem will be trampled by Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled."

On **May 14, 1948**, Israel, miraculously became a nation **again**.

Isaiah 66:8: Who ever heard of such a thing? Has a nation ever been born in a **single day**? Has a country ever come forth in a mere **moment**?

Ezekiel 37:11-13: Then He said to me, "Son of man, these **bones** are the **whole house of Israel**. They indeed say, 'Our bones are dry, our hope is lost, and we ourselves are cut off!' Therefore prophesy and say to them, 'Thus says the Lord God: "Behold, O My people, **I** will open your graves & cause you to come up from your graves, and **bring you into the land of Israel**. Then you shall know that I am the Lord..."'"

Ezekiel 37:21: "Then say to them, 'Thus says the Lord God: "Surely I will take the children of Israel **from among the nations**, wherever they have gone, and will gather them from every side and bring them into their **own land**..."'"

A great **army**!

Daniel 9 - 70 "weeks"

Daniel 9:27: Then **he** shall confirm a covenant with many for one **week (7)**; But in the **middle** of the week **He** shall bring an end to **sacrifice** and **offering**. And on the wing of abominations shall be **one** who makes **desolate**.

Matthew 24:15, 21: Therefore when you see the **abomination of desolation**, spoken of by **Daniel** the prophet, standing in the holy place (**whoever reads, let him understand**)... For then there will be **great tribulation**, such as has not been since the **beginning of the world** until this time, no, **nor ever shall be**.

Revelation 11:1-2: Rise and measure the **temple** of God, the altar, and those who worship there. **But** leave out the **court which is outside the temple**, and do not measure it, for it has been **given to the Gentiles**.

Luke 21:25-27: "And there will be signs in the **sun**, in the **moon**, and in the **stars**; and on the earth **distress** (extreme anxiety) of nations, with **perplexity** (without resources, left wanting, embarrassed, in doubt, not knowing which way to turn), the **sea** and the **waves** roaring; men's hearts **failing** them from **fear** and the expectation of those things which are coming on the earth, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. Then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory."

Luke 21:36: Watch therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy to **escape** all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man.

Luke 21:28: Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift up your heads, because your redemption draws near.

Question: Have you been redeemed?

It is finished!

1 Corinthians 6:19-20: Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

Ephesians 1:13-14: In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory.
