## Watch and Pray Always

Luke 21:25-38

Luke 21:25-27: And there will be <u>signs</u> in the <u>sun</u>, in the <u>moon</u>, and in the <u>stars</u>; and on the earth <u>distress</u> (extreme anxiety) of nations, with <u>perplexity</u> (without resources, left wanting, embarrassed, in doubt, not knowing which way to turn), the <u>sea</u> and the <u>waves</u> roaring; men's hearts <u>failing</u> them from <u>fear</u> and the <u>expectation</u> of those things which are <u>coming on the earth</u>, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. Then they will see the <u>Son of Man coming</u> in a cloud with <u>power</u> and <u>great glory</u>.

Luke 21:28: Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift up your heads, because your redemption draws near.

Q. Have you been redeemed? Left Behind?

It is finished!

1 Corinthians 6:19-20: Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

Luke 21:29-31: Then He spoke to them a <u>parable</u>: "Look at the <u>fig tree</u>, and <u>all the trees</u>. When they are already <u>budding</u>, you see and know for yourselves that <u>summer is now near</u>. So you also, when you see <u>these things</u> happening, know that the <u>kingdom of God</u> is <u>near</u>."

**Luke 21:32:** Assuredly, I say to you, this generation (genea-race) will by no means pass away till all things take place.

Luke 21:33: <u>Heaven</u> and <u>earth</u> will <u>pass away</u>, but <u>My</u> words will <u>by no means pass away</u> (eternal).

Luke 21:34-35: But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down (depressed or dulled) with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that Day come on you unexpectedly. For it will come as a snare on all those who dwell on the face of the whole earth.

Luke 21:36: Watch therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man.

## The Promises of Jesus! -> Luke 21:36

Luke 17:34: I tell you, in that <u>night</u> there will be <u>two in one</u> bed: the <u>one</u> will be <u>taken</u> and the <u>other</u> will be <u>left</u>.

Luke 17:35-36: <u>Two women</u> will be grinding together: the <u>one</u> will be <u>taken</u> and the <u>other left</u>. <u>Two men</u> will be in the field: the <u>one</u> will be <u>taken</u> and the <u>other left</u>.

In **context**, the one that is <u>left</u> is the one that is facing <u>judgment</u> like the days of <u>Noah</u> and <u>Lot</u>!

**Revelation 3:10:** Because you have kept My command to persevere, I also will keep you from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth.

Luke 21:37-38: And in the daytime He was teaching in the temple, but at night He went out and stayed on the mountain called Olivet. Then early in the morning all the people came to Him in the temple to hear Him.

Luke 21:36: <u>Watch</u> therefore, and <u>pray</u> <u>always</u> that you may be <u>counted worthy</u> to <u>escape</u> all <u>these things that</u> <u>will come to pass</u>, and to <u>stand</u> before the Son of Man.
