Satan's Fall From Heaven Luke 10:1-20

Luke 10:1-3: After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go. Then He said to them, "The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest. Go your way; behold, I send you out as lambs among wolves."

Luke 10:17: Then the <u>seventy returned</u> with joy, saying, "Lord, even the <u>demons</u> are <u>subject to us</u> in Your <u>name</u>."

- The demonic realm is **<u>real</u>** and **<u>powerful</u>**!
- The <u>name</u> of **JESUS** is infinitely **MORE** powerful!
- When we come in the <u>name</u> of **JESUS**, the demonic realm **MUST** yield!

Last week we learned...

- Satan is a **murderer**! (John 8:44, 10:10)
- Satan <u>targets</u> children! Leaving parents helpless!
- We learned that **<u>suicide</u>** is often demonic in <u>origin</u>.
- Satan is a **<u>stubborn</u>** foe! (Mark 9:29)

Here in our <u>text</u>, on this **Halloween** weekend: Jesus teaches us that <u>Satan</u> is a <u>fallen</u> foe!

Luke 10:18: And He said to them, "I saw <u>Satan</u> (adversary) <u>fall</u> like <u>lightning</u> from <u>heaven</u>."

Isaiah 14:12-15: "How you are fallen from heaven, Oh Lucifer (light bearer), son of the morning! How you are cut down to the ground, you who weakened the nations! For you have said in your heart: 'I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation on the farthest sides of the north; I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High.' Yet you shall be brought down to Sheol, to the lowest depths of the Pit.

Revelation

- Bound in the **<u>abyss</u>** for 1000 years!
- Then banished eternally to the **lake of fire!**

Ezekiel 28:12-19: You were the <u>seal of perfection</u>, full of <u>wisdom</u> and <u>perfect in beauty</u>. You were in <u>Eden</u>, <u>the</u> <u>garden of God</u>; every precious stone was your covering: the sardius, topaz, and diamond, beryl, onyx, and jasper, sapphire, turquoise, and emerald with gold. The workmanship of your <u>timbrels and pipes</u> was prepared for you on the day you were <u>created</u>. You were the

anointed <u>cherub</u> who <u>covers</u>; I established you; you were on the holy mountain of God; you walked back and forth in the midst of fiery stones. You were perfect in your ways from <u>the day you were created</u>, <u>till iniquity was found</u> <u>in you</u>. By the abundance of your trading you became filled with <u>violence</u> within, and <u>you sinned</u>; therefore <u>I</u> <u>cast you as a profane thing out of the mountain of</u> <u>God</u>; and I destroyed you, oh covering <u>cherub</u>, from the midst of the fiery stones. <u>Your heart was lifted up</u> <u>because of your beauty</u>; you corrupted your wisdom for the sake of your splendor; <u>I cast you to the ground</u>. <u>You</u> <u>have become a horror</u>, and <u>shall be no more forever</u>.

1 Timothy 3:6: ...not a **novice**, lest being **puffed up with pride** he **fall** into the same condemnation as the **devil**.

Revelation 12:9: So the <u>great dragon</u> was cast out, that <u>serpent of old</u>, called the <u>Devil</u> (slanderer) and <u>Satan</u> (adversary) who <u>deceives the whole world</u>; he was cast to the earth, and <u>his angels were cast out with him.</u>

Revelation 12:10: Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, "Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for <u>the accuser of our brethren</u>, who <u>accused them before</u> <u>our God day and night</u>, has been cast down." **Revelation 12:11:** And they <u>overcame</u> him by the • <u>blood of the Lamb</u> and by the • <u>word of their</u> <u>testimony</u>, and they • <u>did not love their lives to the</u> <u>death</u>.

Revelation 12:12: Therefore <u>rejoice</u>, oh heavens. <u>Woe</u> to the inhabitants of the earth. For the <u>devil has come</u> <u>down to you</u>, having <u>great wrath</u>, (<u>enraged</u>) because he knows that he has <u>a short time</u>.

Luke 10:17: Then the <u>seventy returned</u> with <u>joy</u>, saying, "Lord, even the <u>demons</u> are <u>subject to us</u> in Your <u>name</u>."

Luke 10:18: And He said to them, "I saw <u>Satan</u> fall like <u>lightning</u> from <u>heaven</u>."

Luke 10:19: Behold, I give you the <u>authority</u> to trample on <u>serpents</u> and <u>scorpions</u>, and <u>over all the power of</u> <u>the enemy</u>, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Luke 10:20: Nevertheless <u>do not rejoice in this</u>, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather <u>rejoice</u> because your <u>names are written in heaven</u>.

Is your **<u>name</u>** written in <u>**Heaven?**</u>

The <u>Lamb's</u> book of <u>Life</u>

Revelation 20:11-12, 15: Then I saw a great white throne. And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and **books** were opened. And another book was opened, which is **the Book of Life**. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books.
