Jesus Rejoices In The Spirit

Luke 10:21-24

Luke 10:21: In that hour Jesus rejoiced in the Spirit The harvest is great (plentiful):

There is work to be done! (Not saved to be idle!)

The **laborers** are few:

 We <u>labor</u> in <u>response</u> to what Jesus did <u>for</u> <u>us...</u> cross!

Pray the Lord of the harvest:

• **Prayer** is **central** to the harvest.

Go your way:

• As disciples we are **all** called to **Go**! Live on **mission!**

Like lambs among wolves:

 We are weak and vulnerable. (The care of a Good Shepherd)

Carry neither money bag, knapsack, nor sandals:

Where God guides, God provides!

Greet no one along the road:

There is an urgency about us!

Whatever house you enter, say Peace to this house.

• Our message is a message of **peace**

for the laborer is worthy of his wages:

• Financial support given to those who minister the gospel is **not charity**, but **justified wages** for their **work**.

Heal the sick:

• We minister to the **whole person** with the power of God.

Say, The kingdom of God has come near to you:

 Our message too - The <u>King</u> and His <u>kingdom</u> are near.

Mark 1:15: The <u>time is fulfilled</u>, and the <u>kingdom of</u> God is at hand. Repent, and <u>believe</u> in the <u>gospel</u>.

But whatever city you enter, and they do not receive you:

 We don't waste time on those rejecting the gospel.

He who hears you hears Me, he who rejects you rejects Me:

 There will be those that <u>hear</u> us and those that <u>reject</u> us!

The seventy returned with joy:

- <u>Laboring</u> for the Lord leads to a <u>joyful</u> life! <u>Satan fell like lightning from heaven:</u>
 - We have authority over <u>all the power of the</u> enemy!

Luke 10:20: Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather <u>rejoice</u> because your names are **written in heaven**.

Our **chief joy** is **not** in what <u>we can do for the Lord</u>, but is found in what <u>Jesus</u> did <u>for us</u>!

Luke 10:21: In **that hour** Jesus **rejoiced** in the **Spirit**... **Rejoiced**- to **jump** for joy, **leaping** and **skipping** for joy!

Luke 10:21: In that hour <u>Jesus</u> rejoiced in the <u>Spirit</u> and said, "I thank You, <u>Father</u>, Lord of heaven and earth...

Luke 10:21: In that hour <u>Jesus rejoiced in the Spirit</u> and said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth..."

Luke 10:21: In that <u>hour</u> Jesus <u>rejoiced in the Spirit</u> and said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden <u>these things</u> from the <u>wise</u> and <u>prudent</u> (intelligent, learned) and revealed them to <u>babes</u> (weak, unable to speak). Even so, Father, for so it <u>seemed good in Your sight</u>.

1 Corinthians 1:26-31: For you see <u>your calling</u>, brethren, that <u>not many wise</u> according to the flesh, not many <u>mighty</u>, not many <u>noble</u>, are called. But God has chosen the <u>foolish</u> (moros) things of the world to put to shame the wise, and God has chosen the <u>weak</u> things of the world to put to shame the things which are mighty; and the <u>base</u> things of the world & the things which are <u>not</u>,

to bring to nothing the things that are, <u>that no flesh</u> <u>should glory in His presence</u>. As it is written, "He who <u>glories</u>, let him <u>glory</u> in the Lord."

Luke 10:22: All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, and who the Father is except the Son, and **the one to whom the Son wills to reveal Him**.

Luke 10:23-24: Then He turned to His disciples and said privately, "Blessed are the eyes which see the things you see; for I tell you that many prophets and kings have desired to see what you see, and have not seen it, and to hear what you hear, and have not heard it."

John 6:44: No one can **come to Me** unless the **Father** who sent Me **draws him**

Hebrews 3:7-8: Therefore, as the **Holy Spirit** says: "**Today**, if you will hear **His voice**, do not **harden your hearts** in rebellion..."
