

He Has Not Forgotten You

Luke 12:1-12

Luke 12:1: In the meantime, when an innumerable multitude of people had gathered together, so that they trampled one another, He began to say to His disciples first of all, "Beware of the leaven (yeast) of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy."

Mark 12:37: The common people heard Him gladly.

1 Corinthians 5: Paul warns about the leaven of sexual sin.

Luke 12:2: For there is nothing covered that will not be revealed, nor hidden that will not be known.

Psalms 32:1-5: Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man to whom the Lord does not impute iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit. When I kept silent, my bones grew old through my groaning all the day long. For day and night Your hand was heavy upon me; My vitality was turned into the drought of summer. *Selah* I acknowledged my sin to You, and my iniquity I have not hidden. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord," And You forgave the iniquity of my sin. *Selah*

Proverbs 28:13: He who covers his sins will not prosper, but whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.

Luke 12:3: Therefore whatever you have spoken in the dark will be heard in the light, and what you have spoken in the ear in inner rooms will be proclaimed on the housetops.

Matthew 10:27: Whatever I tell you in the dark, speak in the light; and what you hear in the ear, preach on the housetops.

Luke 12:4: And I say to you, My friends, do not be afraid of those who kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do.

John 14:27: Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Acts 1:8: But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

Luke 12:5: But I will show you whom you should fear: **Fear Him** who, after He has killed, has power to cast into **hell**; yes, I say to you, **fear Him!**

Job 28:28: And to man He said, Behold, the **fear of the Lord**, that is **wisdom**, and to **depart from evil** is **understanding**.

Luke 12:6: Are not **five sparrows** sold for **two copper coins**? And not one of them is **forgotten before God**.

You are **NOT forgotten** by God!

Psalms 139:17-18: How precious also are **Your thoughts to me**, O God! How great is the sum of them! If I should count them, they would be **more in number than the sand**;

Isaiah 49:15: Can a woman forget her nursing child, and not have **compassion** on the son of her womb? Surely they may forget, **Yet I will not forget you!**

Luke 12:7: But the very **hairs** of your head are **all numbered**. **Do not fear** therefore; **you are of more value** than many **sparrows**.

You are **VALUABLE** to God!

Matthew 6:26: your Heavenly Father

Luke 12:8-9: Also I say to you, **whoever confesses Me before men**, him the **Son of Man** also will **confess** before the **angels** of God. But he who **denies** Me before men will be **denied** before the **angels** of God.

Matthew 10:32-33: Therefore whoever **confesses Me** before **men**, him I will also **confess** before **My Father** who is in heaven. But whoever **denies Me** before men, him I will also **deny** before **My Father** who is in heaven.

Luke 12:10: And anyone who speaks **a word against the Son of Man**, it will be **forgiven him**; but to him who **blasphemes against the Holy Spirit**, it will **not be forgiven**.

Luke 12:11-12: Now when they bring you to the synagogues and magistrates and authorities, **do not worry** about how or what you should answer, or what you should say. For the **Holy Spirit** will **teach you in that very hour** what you ought to say.

Matthew 10:19-20: But when they deliver you up, **do not worry** about how or what you should speak. For it will be **given to you in that hour** what you should **speak**; for it is **not you who speak**, but **the Spirit** of your Father who speaks in **you**.

Matthew 12:31-32: Therefore I say to you, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven men, but the blasphemy against the Spirit will not be forgiven men. Anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven him; but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it will not be forgiven him, either in this age or in the age to come.
