He Has Not Forgotten You

Luke 12:1-12

Luke 12:1: In the meantime, when an <u>innumerable</u> multitude of people had gathered together, so that they <u>trampled one another</u>, He began to say to His <u>disciples</u> first of all, "<u>Beware</u> of the <u>leaven</u> (yeast) of the Pharisees, which is <u>hypocrisy</u>."

Mark 12:37: The common people heard Him gladly.

1 Corinthians 5: Paul warns about the <u>leaven</u> of <u>sexual sin</u>.

Luke 12:2: For there is nothing **covered** that will not be **revealed**, nor **hidden** that will not be **known**.

Psalm 32:1-5: Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man to whom the Lord does not impute iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit. When I kept silent, my bones grew old through my groaning all the day long. For day and night Your hand was heavy upon me; My vitality was turned into the drought of summer. Selah I acknowledged my sin to You, and my iniquity I have not hidden. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord," And You forgave the iniquity of my sin. Selah

Proverbs 28:13: He who <u>covers</u> his sins will <u>not prosper</u>, but whoever <u>confesses</u> and <u>forsakes</u> them will have <u>mercy</u>.

Luke 12:3: Therefore **whatever** you have **spoken** in the **dark** will be heard in the **light**, and what you have **spoken** in the **ear** in **inner rooms** will be **proclaimed** on the **housetops**.

Matthew 10:27: Whatever I tell you in the dark, speak in the light; and what you hear in the ear, preach on the housetops.

Luke 12:4: And I say to you, **My friends**, **do not be afraid** of those who **kill the body**, and after that have no more that they can do.

John 14:27: <u>Peace</u> I <u>leave</u> with you, <u>My peace</u> I <u>give</u> to **you**; not <u>as the world gives</u> do I give to you. Let not your heart be <u>troubled</u>, neither let it be <u>afraid</u>.

Acts 1:8: But you shall receive <u>power</u> when the <u>Holy</u>

<u>Spirit</u> has come <u>upon</u> you; and you shall be <u>witnesses</u> to Me in <u>Jerusalem</u>, and in all <u>Judea</u> and <u>Samaria</u>, and to the <u>end of the earth</u>.

Luke 12:5: But I will show you whom you should fear: **Fear Him** who, after He has killed, has power to cast into **hell**; yes, I say to you, **fear Him**!

Job 28:28: And to man He said, Behold, the <u>fear of the</u> <u>Lord</u>, that is <u>wisdom</u>, and to <u>depart from evil</u> is <u>understanding</u>.

Luke 12:6: Are not <u>five sparrows</u> sold for <u>two copper</u> <u>coins</u>? And not one of them is <u>forgotten before God</u>.

You are NOT forgotten by God!

Psalm 139:17-18: How precious also are **Your thoughts to me**, O God! How great is the sum of them! If I should count them, they would be **more in number than the sand**;

Isaiah 49:15: Can a woman forget her nursing child, and not have **compassion** on the son of her womb? Surely they may forget, **Yet I will not forget you!**

Luke 12:7: But the very <u>hairs</u> of your head are <u>all</u> <u>numbered</u>. <u>Do not fear</u> therefore; <u>you are of more value</u> than many <u>sparrows</u>.

You are **VALUABLE** to God!

Matthew 6:26: your Heavenly Father

Luke 12:8-9: Also I say to you, whoever confesses Me before men, him the Son of Man also will confess before the angels of God. But he who denies Me before men will be denied before the angels of God.

Matthew 10:32-33: Therefore whoever <u>confesses Me</u> before <u>men</u>, him I will also <u>confess</u> before <u>My Father</u> who is in heaven. But whoever <u>denies Me</u> before men, him I will also <u>deny</u> before <u>My Father</u> who is in heaven.

Luke 12:10: And anyone who speaks <u>a word against</u> the <u>Son of Man</u>, it will be <u>forgiven him</u>; but to him who <u>blasphemes against the Holy Spirit</u>, it will <u>not be</u> <u>forgiven</u>.

Luke 12:11-12: Now when they bring you to the synagogues and magistrates and authorities, do not worry about how or what you should answer, or what you should say. For the Holy Spirit will teach you in that very hour what you ought to say.

Matthew 10:19-20: But when they deliver you up, <u>do</u> <u>not worry</u> about how or what you should speak. For it will be <u>given to you in that hour</u> what you should <u>speak</u>; for it is <u>not you who speak</u>, but <u>the Spirit</u> of your Father who speaks in <u>you</u>.

Matthew 12:31-32: Therefore I say to you, <u>every sin</u> and <u>blasphemy</u> will be <u>forgiven men</u>, but the <u>blasphemy</u> <u>against the Spirit</u> will <u>not be forgiven men</u>. Anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven him; but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it will <u>not be forgiven him</u>, either in <u>this age</u> or in <u>the age to come</u>.
