## Zacharias' Prophecy

Luke 1:57-80

Luke 1:57-58: Now <u>Elizabeth's</u> <u>full</u> <u>time</u> came for her to be delivered, and she brought forth a <u>son</u>. When her neighbors and relatives heard how the Lord had shown <u>great mercy</u> to her, they <u>rejoiced</u> with her.

Luke 1:59-60: So it was, on the **<u>eighth day</u>**, that they came to **<u>circumcise</u>** the child; and they would have called him by the name of his father, **<u>Zacharias</u>**. His mother answered and said, "No; he shall be called **<u>John</u>**."

Luke 1:61-62: But they said to her, "There is no one among your relatives who is called by this name." So they made <u>signs to his father</u> - what he would have him called.

Interesting: Earlier **<u>mute</u>** (v.20)...now we learn <u>**deaf**</u> too!

Luke 1:63-64: And he asked for a writing tablet, and wrote, saying, "<u>His name is</u> <u>John</u>." So they all marveled. Immediately his <u>mouth was opened</u> and his <u>tongue loosed</u>, and he spoke, <u>praising God</u>.

Luke 1:65-66: Then fear came on all who dwelt around them; and all these <u>sayings</u> were <u>discussed throughout all the hill country of Judea</u>. And all those who heard them kept them in their hearts, saying, "<u>What kind of child will this</u> <u>be</u>?" And the <u>hand of the Lord</u> was with him.

Luke 1:67: Now his father Zacharias was **<u>filled with the Holy Spirit</u>**, and **<u>prophesied</u>**, saying:

Numbers 11:25-26

1 Corinthians 14:5: I wish you all spoke with **tongues**, but **even more** that you **prophesied**... that the church might be **edified**.

Zacharias was a man *immersed* in the Scriptures. Ex!

There are some **16** Old Testament allusions or quotations.

Luke 1:68: "**Blessed** (Praise) is the Lord God of Israel, for He has visited and redeemed His people,

## Filled with HS v. 67- (1) Praised (2) Prophesied

Luke 1:69: And has raised up a horn of <u>salvation</u> for us in the <u>house of His</u> <u>servant David</u>,

2 Samuel 7

Luke 1:70: As He spoke by the mouth of His **holy prophets**, who have been since the world began,

Luke 1:71: That we should be **<u>saved</u>** from our enemies and from the hand of all who hate us,

Luke 1:72-73: To perform the mercy **promised** to our fathers and to remember His **holy covenant**, the oath which He swore to our father **Abraham**:

Luke 1:74: To grant us that we, being delivered from the hand of our enemies, might **<u>serve</u>** Him without fear,

Always been Gods plan! Saved that we might **<u>serve</u> <u>Him</u>**!

Luke 1:75: In holiness and righteousness before Him all the days of our life.

Pray that!

Luke 1:76: "And you, <u>child</u>, will be called the <u>prophet of the Highest</u>; for you will go before the face of the <u>Lord</u> to prepare His ways,

Luke 1:77: To give knowledge of <u>salvation</u> to His people by the <u>remission of</u> <u>their sins</u>,

## John 1:29

Luke 1:78: Through the **tender mercy** of our God, with which the **Dayspring** (Sunrise) from on **<u>high</u>** has **<u>visited</u>** us;

Luke 1:79: To give <u>light</u> to those who sit in <u>darkness</u> & the <u>shadow of death</u>, to guide our feet into the way of <u>peace</u>.

- Malachi 4:2: The <u>Sun of Righteousness</u> shall arise with <u>healing in His</u> <u>wings</u>; <u>And you shall go out</u> and <u>grow fat like stall-fed calves</u>.
- Revelation 22:16: **<u>Bright</u>** and <u>**Morning Star**</u>!
- 2 Peter 1:19: Morning Star

To guide our feet into the way of **<u>peace</u>**.

Luke 1:80: So the <u>child</u> <u>grew</u> and became <u>strong in spirit</u>, and was in the <u>deserts</u> till the day of his manifestation to Israel.
