Luke 2:40: And the Child grew and became strong in spirit, filled with wisdom; and the grace of God was upon Him.

Proverbs 3:11-12: My son, do not despise the chastening of the Lord, Nor detest His correction; for whom the Lord loves He corrects, just as a father the son in whom he delights.
