Do This In Remembrance Of Me Luke 22:7-23

Luke 22:7: Then came the <u>Day of Unleavened Bread</u>, when the <u>Passover</u> must be <u>killed</u>.

Luke 22:8: And <u>He</u> sent <u>Peter</u> and <u>John</u>, saying, "Go and prepare the Passover for us, that we may eat."

Two by two

Ecclesiastes 4:9-12: <u>Two</u> are better than one, because they have a good reward for their labor. For if they fall, one will lift up his companion. But woe to him who is <u>alone</u> when he falls, for he has no one to help him up. Again, if <u>two</u> lie down together, they will keep warm; But how can one be warm <u>alone</u>? Though one may be overpowered by another, <u>two</u> can withstand him. And a <u>threefold cord</u> is not quickly broken.

Luke 22:9: So they said to Him, "Where do You want us to prepare?"

Luke 22:10: And He said to them, "Behold, when you have entered the city, a man will meet you carrying a pitcher of water; follow him into the house which he enters."

Luke 22:11: Then you shall say to the <u>master</u> (owner) of the <u>house</u>, "the <u>Teacher</u> says to you, 'Where is the <u>guest</u> room where I may eat the Passover <u>with My disciples</u>?'"

Luke 22:12: Then he will show you <u>a large, furnished</u> <u>upper room</u>; there make ready.

Luke 22:13: So they went and found it just as He had said to them, and they <u>prepared</u> the <u>Passover</u>.

Luke 22:14: When the <u>hour</u> had come, He sat down, and the <u>twelve</u> apostles with Him.

Luke 22:15: Then He said to them, "With <u>fervent desire</u> I have desired to eat <u>this Passover</u> with you before I <u>suffer</u>...

Luke 22:16: ...for I say to you, I will no longer eat of it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God."

Luke 22:17-18: Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, "Take this and divide (share) it among yourselves; for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." (Matthew 26:29)

Luke 22:19: And He took <u>bread</u>, <u>gave thanks</u> and <u>broke</u> <u>it</u>, and gave it to them, saying, "This is <u>My body</u> which is <u>given for you</u>; <u>do this</u> in <u>remembrance</u> of <u>Me</u>."

Luke 22:20: Likewise He also took the cup <u>after supper</u>, saying, "This <u>cup</u> is the <u>new covenant</u> in <u>My blood</u>, which is shed <u>for you</u>."

Ezekiel 36:26-27: I will give you a <u>new heart</u>, and I will put a <u>new spirit</u> in you. I will take out your <u>stony</u>, <u>stubborn</u> heart and give you a <u>tender</u>, <u>responsive</u> heart. I will put <u>My Spirit</u> within you and <u>cause you</u> to <u>walk</u> in My <u>statutes</u>, and you will <u>keep</u> My <u>judgments</u> and <u>do them</u>.

1 John 1:7: But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the **blood** of Jesus Christ His Son <u>cleanses us from all sin</u>.

Luke 22:21-23: "But behold, the hand of My betrayer is with Me on the table. And <u>truly</u> the <u>Son of Man goes as it has been determined</u>, but <u>woe</u> to that man by whom He is betrayed!" Then they began to question among themselves, which of them it was who would do this thing.

Revelation 13:8: ...the <u>Lamb slain</u> from the <u>foundation of</u> the world.

Matthew 26:30: And when they had <u>sung</u> a hymn, they went out to the <u>Mount of Olives</u>.
