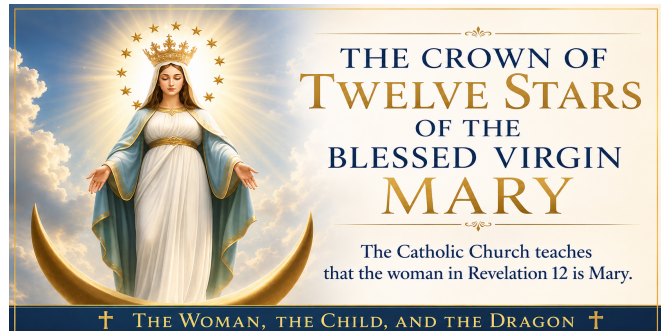


The Woman, the Child and the Dragon

Revelation 12:1-11

Revelation 12:1 Now a great sign (great significance) appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a garland of twelve stars.



This woman is the nation of Israel. (Genesis 37:9-10)

Revelation 12:2 Then being with Child, she cried out in labor and in pain to give birth.

Revelation 12:3 And another sign (great significance) appeared in heaven: behold, a great, fiery red dragon having seven heads (intelligent) and ten horns (powerful), and seven diadems / crowns (reign) on his heads.

- Cain murdered Abel! / Abel - First Shepherd of the Bible
- Pharaoh / Moses the savior / Pharaoh publicly defeated!
- Haman / 13th of Adar / Gallows
- Herod (Micah 5:2)

Next week we will see in the last days the dragon persecutes (v.13) and is enraged (v.17) with the woman (Israel) who brought the Child (Jesus) — **Antisemitism!**

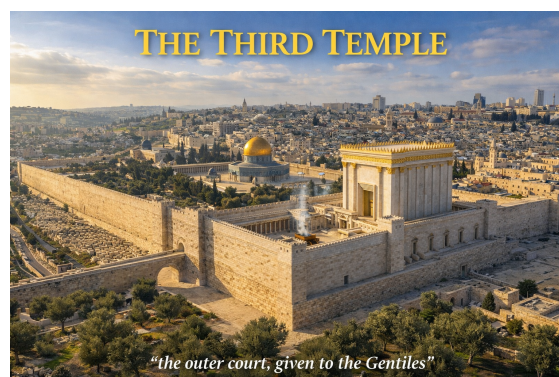
Revelation 12:5: She bore a male Child who was to rule (shepherd) all nations with a rod of iron (Psalm 2). And her Child was caught up to God and His throne.

Revelation 12:6: Then the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, that they should feed her there one thousand two hundred and sixty days (3.5 years).

God is not done with Israel



Revelation 12:7-8: And war broke out in heaven: Michael and his angels fought with the dragon; and the dragon and his angels fought, but they did not prevail, nor was a place found for them in heaven any longer.



Revelation 12:9: So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil (34x- accuser) & Satan (54x-enemy), who deceives the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. (v12 Rejoice oh heavens! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth!)

Revelation 12:10: Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, "Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down."

Revelation 12:11: And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

Revelation 1:5: ...To Him (glory) who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood,
