A Compromising Church

Revelation 2:12-17

Revelation 2:12: And to the <u>angel</u> of the <u>church</u> in <u>Pergamos</u> write, 'These things says <u>He who has the sharp</u> <u>two-edged sword</u>: (Revelation 1:16, 2:12,16, 19:15)

1 Timothy 4:1-2: The Spirit expressly says that in later times <u>some</u> will <u>depart</u> from the (Historical Christian) <u>faith</u>, giving heed to <u>deceiving spirits</u> and <u>doctrines of demons...</u>

Revelation 2:13: "I know your works, and where you dwell, where Satan's throne is. And you hold fast to My name, and did not deny My faith even in the days in which Antipas was My faithful martyr, who was killed among you, where Satan dwells."

Revelation 2:14: But I have a few things against you, because you have there those who hold the <u>doctrine</u> of <u>Balaam</u>, who taught <u>Balak</u> to put a <u>stumbling block</u> before the children of Israel, to eat things <u>sacrificed to idols</u>, and to commit <u>sexual immorality</u>.

1. Idolatry: Putting anything—person, thing, or desire—above God's rightful place in your heart. A rival throne.

Idolatry: When the <u>gifts</u> that God has given us become greater than the <u>Giver</u>.

2. Sexual Immorality: Sex outside God's design of marriage.

Revelation 2:15: Thus you also have those who hold the doctrine of the <u>Nicolaitans</u>, which thing <u>I hate</u>.

3. The doctrine of the Nicolaitans.

Revelation 2:16: Repent, or else I will come to <u>you</u> quickly and will <u>fight</u> against <u>them</u> with the <u>sword of My mouth</u>.

Mark 1:14-15: The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.

Luke 13:3: ...unless you <u>repent</u> you will all likewise <u>perish</u>.

Acts 2:38: Repent and let every one of you be <u>baptized</u> in the name of Jesus Christ for the <u>forgiveness</u> of sins; and you shall receive the <u>gift</u> of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 3:19: Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord.

Romans 2:4: ...the <u>kindness</u> of God leads you to <u>repentance</u>?

2 Timothy 2:25: ...if God perhaps will <u>grant</u> them <u>repentance</u>, so that they may know the <u>truth</u>.

2 Peter 3:9: The Lord is ...not willing that any should perish but that <u>all</u> should come to <u>repentance</u>.

Revelation 2:5: <u>Remember</u> therefore from where you have <u>fallen</u> (fallen away); <u>repent</u> (turn back to Me) and <u>do</u> (redo) the first works...

Revelation 2:16: Repent, or else I will come to you quickly and will fight against them with the sword of My mouth.

Revelation 3:19: As many as I <u>love</u>, I <u>rebuke</u> and <u>chasten</u>. Therefore be zealous and <u>repent</u>.

1 Corinthians 11:31: For if we would <u>judge</u> <u>ourselves</u>, we would not be <u>judged</u>.

Revelation 2:17: "He who has <u>an ear</u>, let him <u>hear</u> what the <u>Spirit says</u> to the <u>churches</u>. To him who <u>overcomes</u>! will give some of the <u>hidden manna</u> to eat."

JESUS is the true manna!

John 6:51: "I am the living bread which came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world."

John 6:35: And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst."

Revelation 2:17: ...and I will give him a <u>white stone</u>, and on the stone <u>a new name</u> written which no one knows except him who receives it.

Repentance is central to salvation! Sanctification!
