

# The Bowl Judgments

## Revelation 16

Revelation 16:1: Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying to the seven angels, "Go and pour out the bowls of the wrath of God on the earth."

1 Thessalonians 1:9-10: How you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God, and to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, even Jesus who delivers (rescues) us from the wrath to come.

1 Thessalonians 5:9: For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Revelation 16:2: So the first (angel) went and poured out his bowl upon the earth, and a foul and loathsome sore (Exodus) came upon the men who had the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image.

### Chapter 13: Dragon, Antichrist, False Prophet

Revelation 14:9-10: If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives his mark on his forehead or on his hand, he himself shall also drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out full strength into the cup of His indignation.

Revelation 16:3: Then the second angel poured out his bowl on the sea, and it became blood (Exodus) as of a dead man; and every living creature in the sea died.

Revelation 16:4: Then the third angel poured out his bowl on the rivers and springs of water, and they became blood.

Revelation 16:5: And I heard the angel of the waters saying: You are righteous (just), oh Lord, The One who is and who was and who is to be, because You have judged these things.

Revelation 16:6: For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets and You have given them blood to drink. For it is their just due.

Revelation 16:7: I heard another from the altar saying, even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous (just) are Your judgments.

Romans 3:26: God is just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

Revelation 16:8-9: Then the fourth angel poured out his bowl on the sun, and power was given to him to scorch men with fire. And men were scorched with great heat and they blasphemed the name of God who has power over these plagues and they did not repent and give Him glory.

Revelation 16:10: Then the fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and his kingdom became full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues because of the pain.

Exodus 10:22: (9th Plague) ... thick darkness for 3 days. But all the children of Israel had light in their dwellings.

Revelation 16:11: They blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and did not repent of their deeds.

Revelation 16:12: Then the sixth angel poured out his bowl on the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up, so that the way of the kings from the east might be prepared.

Revelation 16:13-14: And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs coming out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. For they are spirits of demons, performing signs, which go out to the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.

Revelation 16:15: Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed is he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and they see his shame.

Revelation 16:16: And they gathered them together to the place called in Hebrew, Armageddon. (Future study)

Revelation 16:17: Then the seventh angel poured out his bowl into the air, and a loud voice came out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, "It is done!"

Revelation 16:18: And there were noises and thunderings and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such a mighty and great earthquake as had not occurred since men were on the earth.

**Revelation 16:19:** Now the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. And great Babylon was remembered before God, to give her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of His wrath.

**Revelation 16:20:** Then every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.

**Revelation 16:21:** And great hail from heaven fell upon men, each hailstone about the weight of a talent. (100 lbs) Men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail, since that plague was exceedingly great.

**Revelation 9:20-21:** But the rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands, that they should not worship demons, and idols of gold, silver, brass, stone, and wood, which can neither see nor hear nor walk. And they did not repent of their murders or their sorceries or their sexual immorality or their thefts.
