Humble MORE IN 2024

Exodus 10:3: So Moses and Aaron came in to <u>Pharaoh</u> and said to him, "Thus says the Lord God of the Hebrews: '<u>How long will you refuse to HUMBLE yourself before</u> <u>Me</u>? Let My people go, that they may <u>serve</u> Me.' "

Numbers 12:3: Now the man <u>Moses</u> was very <u>**HUMBLE**</u>, more than all men who were on the face of the earth.

Daniel 5:22-23: But you his son, <u>Belshazzar</u>, have <u>not</u>

<u>HUMBLED your heart</u>, although you <u>knew</u> all this. And you have <u>lifted yourself up against the Lord</u> of heaven and the <u>God who holds your breath in His hand</u> and <u>owns all your ways</u>, <u>you have not glorified</u>.

What is the PURPOSE of life?

- 1. Know God!
- 2. To bring Glory to God!

Daniel 10:3: I ate <u>no pleasant food</u>, <u>no meat</u> or <u>wine</u> came into my mouth, nor did I anoint myself at all, till <u>three whole weeks</u> were fulfilled.

Daniel 10:11: And he said to me, "Oh Daniel, man **greatly beloved...**"

Daniel 10:12: Then he said to me, "Do not fear, Daniel, for from the <u>first day</u> that you <u>set your heart to</u> <u>understand</u>, and to <u>HUMBLE</u> yourself before your God, <u>your words were heard</u>; and <u>I have come because of your words</u>."

Daniel 10:19: And he said, "Oh man greatly beloved, fear not! Peace be to you; be strong, yes, be strong!"

2 Chronicles 7:14: If My people who are called by My name will HUMBLE themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

Ezra 8:21-23: Then I proclaimed a <u>fast</u> at the river of Ahava, that we might <u>HUMBLE</u> ourselves before our God, to <u>seek from Him the right way for us and our little ones</u> and all our possessions. <u>The hand of our God is upon all those for good who seek Him</u>, but His <u>power</u> and His <u>wrath</u> are against all those who <u>forsake Him</u>. So we <u>fasted and entreated our God</u> for this and <u>He answered our prayer</u>.

Psalm 119:71: It is good for me that I have been **afflicted**, (**HUMBLED**) that I may **learn Your statutes** (The Word).

Psalm 119:67: Before I was <u>afflicted</u> (<u>HUMBLED</u>) I went <u>astray</u>: but now <u>I closely follow your Word</u>.

Isaiah 57:15: For this is what the <u>High</u> and <u>Exalted One</u> says, <u>He who lives forever</u>, whose name is <u>Holy</u>: "I live in a high and holy place, <u>but</u> also with the one who is <u>contrite</u> (bruised, crushed, discouraged, broken) and <u>HUMBLE</u> (lowly in spirit), to <u>revive</u> the spirit of the <u>lowly</u> and to <u>revive</u> the heart of the <u>contrite</u>.

revive: To give life, make alive, to refresh, restore, rebuild, to make whole

Micah 6:8: He has shown you, Oh man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to **do justly** (right), to **love mercy**, and to **walk HUMBLY with your God.**

Luke 18:14: Whoever <u>exalts</u> himself will be <u>HUMBLED</u> and he who <u>HUMBLES</u> himself will be <u>exalted</u>.

1 Peter 5:5-7: God <u>resists</u> the proud, but gives <u>grace to</u> <u>the HUMBLE</u>. Therefore <u>HUMBLE</u> yourselves under the <u>mighty hand of God</u>, that He may <u>exalt you</u> (lift you up) in due time, <u>casting all your care upon Him</u>, for <u>He cares for you</u>.

James 4:6: But He gives **more grace**. Therefore He says: "God **resists** the proud, but gives **grace to the HUMBLE**."

Ephesians 2:4-5: <u>But God</u>, who is <u>rich in mercy</u>, because of His <u>great love</u> with which <u>He loved us</u>, even when we were <u>dead in trespasses</u>, made us <u>alive</u> together with Christ (by <u>grace</u> you have been <u>saved</u>).

Ephesians 2:8-9: For by **grace** you have been **saved** through **faith**, and that **not of yourselves**; it is the **gift of God**, not of **works**, lest anyone should boast.

James 4:6: But He gives **more grace**. Therefore He says: "God <u>resists</u> the proud, but gives <u>grace to the</u> **HUMBLE**."

Hebrews 4:16: Let <u>us</u> therefore come <u>boldly</u> to the <u>throne of grace</u>, that we may obtain <u>mercy</u> and <u>find</u> <u>grace</u> to help in <u>time of need</u>.

- **2 Chronicles 16:9:** For the <u>eyes of the Lord</u> run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show Himself <u>strong</u> on behalf of those whose <u>heart</u> is <u>loyal to Him</u> (<u>fully committed to Him</u>).
- **2 Chronicles 27:6:** So Jotham became <u>mighty</u> because he <u>ordered</u> his ways before the Lord his God.
- **2 Chronicles 26:15:** Uzziah was <u>marvelously helped</u> by the Lord until he was <u>strong</u>.

Isaiah 37:14: Hezekiah received the letter from the hand of the messengers, and read it; and Hezekiah went up to the house of the Lord, and **spread it before the Lord**.
