Exodus 10:3: So Moses and Aaron came in to Pharaoh and said to him, "Thus says the Lord God of the Hebrews: 'How long will you refuse to HUMBLE yourself before Me? Let My people go, that they may serve Me.' "

Numbers 12:3: Now the man Moses was very HUMBLE, more than all men who were on the face of the earth.

Daniel 5:22-23: But you his son, Belshazzar, have not HUMBLED your heart, although you knew all this. And you have lifted yourself up against the Lord of heaven and the God who holds your breath in His hand and owns all your ways, you have not glorified.

What is the PURPOSE of life?

1. Know God!
2. To bring Glory to God!

Daniel 10:3: I ate no pleasant food, no meat or wine came into my mouth, nor did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled.

Daniel 10:11: And he said to me, "Oh Daniel, man greatly beloved..."

Daniel 10:12: Then he said to me, "Do not fear, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart to understand, and to HUMBLE yourself before your God, your words were heard; and I have come because of your words."

Daniel 10:19: And he said, "Oh man greatly beloved, fear not! Peace be to you; be strong, yes, be strong!"

2 Chronicles 7:14: If My people who are called by My name will HUMBLE themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

Ezra 8:21-23: Then I proclaimed a fast at the river of Ahava, that we might HUMBLE ourselves before our God, to seek from Him the right way for us and our little ones and all our possessions. The hand of our God is upon all those for good who seek Him, but His power and His wrath are against all those who forsake Him. So we fasted and entreated our God for this and He answered our prayer.

Psalm 119:71: It is good for me that I have been **afflicted**, (**HUMBLE**D) that I may learn Your statutes (The Word).

Psalm 119:67: Before I was **afflicted** (**HUMBLE**D) I went **astray**: but now I closely follow your Word.

Isaiah 57:15: For this is what the **High** and **Exalted One** says, He who lives forever, whose name is **Holy**: "I live in a high and holy place, **but** also with the one who is **contrite** (bruised, crushed, discouraged, broken) and **HUMBLE** (lowly in spirit), to **revive** the spirit of the **lowly** and to **revive** the heart of the **contrite**.

revive: To give life, make alive, to refresh, restore, rebuild, to make whole

Micah 6:8: He has shown you, Oh man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to **do justly** (right), to **love mercy**, and to walk **HUMBLY** with your God.

Luke 18:14: Whoever **exalts** himself will be **HUMBLE**D and he who **HUMBLE**S himself will be **exalted**.

1 Peter 5:5-7: God resists the proud, but gives grace to the HUMBLE. Therefore HUMBLE yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you (lift you up) in due time, casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

James 4:6: But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the HUMBLE."

Ephesians 2:4-5: But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved).

Ephesians 2:8-9: For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.

James 4:6: But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the HUMBLE."

Hebrews 4:16: Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

2 Chronicles 16:9: For the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show Himself **strong** on behalf of those whose heart is loyal to Him (**fully committed to Him**).

2 Chronicles 27:6: So Jotham became **mighty** because he ordered his ways before the Lord his God.

2 Chronicles 26:15: Uzziah was marvelously helped by the Lord until he was **strong**.

Isaiah 37:14: Hezekiah received the letter from the hand of the messengers, and read it; and Hezekiah went up to the house of the Lord, and spread it before the Lord.
