Jesus Cleanses the Temple Luke 19:45-48

Luke 19:41-42: Now as **He drew near**, He saw the **city** and **wept** over it, saying, "If you had **known**, even you, **especially** in this **your day**, the things that make for your **peace**! But now they are **hidden** from your eyes."

Luke 19:43-44: "For days will come upon you when your enemies will build an embankment around you, surround you and close you in on every side, and level you, and your children within you, to the ground; and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not know the time of your visitation."

Luke 19:45: Then He went into the temple and began to drive out those who bought and sold in it.






Mark 11:11: And Jesus went into Jerusalem and <u>into the temple</u>. So when He had <u>looked around</u> at <u>all things</u>, as the hour was already late, He went out to <u>Bethany</u> with the twelve.

Luke 19:45: Then He went into the temple and began to drive out those who bought and sold in it.

John 2:13: Now the <u>Passover</u> of the Jews was at hand, and Jesus went <u>up</u> to <u>Jerusalem</u>.

John 2:14: And He found in the temple those who sold oxen and sheep and doves, and the money changers doing business.



John 2:15: When He had made a <u>whip of cords</u>, <u>He</u> drove them all out of the temple, with the <u>sheep and</u> the oxen, and poured out the changers' money and overturned the tables.

John 2:16: And He said to those who sold doves, "Take these things away! Do not make My Father's house a house of merchandise!"

John 5:17-18: But Jesus answered them, "My Father has been working until now, and I have been working." Therefore the Jews sought all the more to kill Him, because He not only broke the Sabbath, but also said that God was His Father, making Himself equal with God.

Jesus is the **gentle Lamb of God**.

John 1:29: The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" A very angry Jesus.

Ephesians 4:26-27: Be <u>angry</u>, and <u>do not sin</u>: do not let the sun go down on your wrath, nor give place to the devil.

Christ rejecting planet Earth!

Revelation 6:16-17: <u>Wrath</u> of the <u>Lamb</u>! For the great day of <u>His wrath</u> has come, and who is able to stand?

Luke 19:45-46: Then <u>He went into the temple</u> and began to <u>drive out those who bought and sold in it</u>, saying to them, "It is written, <u>My house</u> is a <u>house of prayer</u>, (Isa. 56:7) but you have made it a <u>den of thieves</u>." (Jer. 7:11)

Mark 11:17: My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations.

Jesus is the **fulfillment**.

- Sacrifices
- Law

- Sabbath
- Tabernacle / Temple



John 1:1,14: In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. And the Word became flesh and dwelt (tabernacled) among us.

2 Corinthians 5:19: God was in Christ <u>reconciling</u> the <u>world</u> to Himself.

Revelation 5:9: And they sang a <u>new song</u>, saying: "You are <u>worthy...</u> For You were <u>slain</u>, and have <u>redeemed us</u> to God by Your <u>blood</u> out of every <u>tribe</u> and <u>tongue</u> and <u>people</u> and <u>nation.</u>"

Luke 19:47-48: And **He was teaching daily in the temple**. But the **chief priests**, the **scribes**, and the **leaders** of the people sought to **destroy Him**, and were unable to do anything; for all **the people** were **very attentive to hear Him**.

- The temple needed <u>cleansed</u>.
- **<u>Prayer</u>** in the temple needed <u>**restored</u>**!</u>
- Jesus was **teaching daily** in the temple.
- All the people are very attentive to hear Him.

- 1 Corinthians 3:16: Do you not know that you are the <u>temple of God</u> and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?
- **2 Corinthians 5:19:** God was in Christ <u>reconciling</u> the <u>world</u> to Himself.
- 1 Timothy 2:4-6: <u>God desires</u> all men to be <u>saved</u> and to come to the <u>knowledge of the truth</u>. For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself a <u>ransom for all</u>, to be testified in **due time**.
