Feasting and Fasting

Luke 5:27-35

Luke 5:27-29: After these things **He went out** and **saw a tax collector** named **Levi**, sitting at the **tax office**. And He said to him, "**Follow Me**." So he **left all**, rose up, and followed Him.

Luke 5:29: Then Levi <u>gave Him</u> a <u>great feast</u> in his <u>own</u> house. And there were <u>a great number of tax collectors</u> and <u>others</u> who sat down with them.

Mark 2:15: Now it happened, as He was dining in <u>Levi's</u> <u>house</u>, that many <u>tax collectors</u> and <u>sinners</u> also sat together with <u>Jesus and His disciples</u>; for there were many, and <u>they followed Him</u>.

Heart, House, and Hand

Luke 5:30: And their <u>scribes</u> and the <u>Pharisees</u> <u>complained</u> against <u>His disciples</u>, saying, "Why do You <u>eat</u> and <u>drink</u> with <u>tax collectors</u> and <u>sinners</u>?"

We shouldn't be <u>repulsed</u> by <u>sinners</u> but as Jesus' followers... we should be drawn to sinners!

Hate the sin, but love the sinner!

Sinners should **not** be <u>repelled by us</u>, but as <u>true</u>

Jesus <u>followers</u>, sinners should be <u>drawn to us</u>,
sensing that we <u>love</u> them & have the <u>life</u> that they
are looking for!

Luke 5:31-32: Jesus answered and said to them, "Those who are <u>well</u> have no need of a <u>physician</u>, but those who are <u>sick</u>. I have not come to call the <u>righteous</u>, but <u>sinners</u>, to <u>repentance</u>."

Mark 1:15: The <u>time</u> is fulfilled, and the <u>kingdom of</u> God is <u>at hand</u>. <u>Repent</u>, and <u>believe</u> in the <u>gospel</u>.

Luke 5:33: Then they said to <u>Him</u>, "Why do the disciples of John <u>fast</u> often and make <u>prayers</u>, and likewise those of the Pharisees, <u>but</u> Yours <u>eat</u> and <u>drink</u>?"

Jesus both <u>modeled</u> and <u>taught</u> his disciples to <u>pray</u> and to <u>fast</u>!

Jesus also modeled eating and drinking wine!

Luke 7: Glutton and Drunkard

We learn from Jesus both **Fasting** & **Feasting!**

Conviction vs **Legalism**

Luke 5:34: And He said to them, "Can you make the **friends** of the **bridegroom fast** while the **bridegroom** is with them?"

A Wedding Celebration!

Jesus is the bridgeroom/groom!

Jesus is **coming again** to take a **bride**!

Are you part of the **bride** of Jesus, **dressed in white**?

Revelation 1:5: <u>To Him</u> who <u>loved us</u> and <u>washed us</u> from our <u>sins</u> in His own <u>blood</u>

Revelation: 9 times, "<u>clothed</u> in fine linen, <u>white</u> and <u>clean</u>"

Luke 5:34: But the <u>days will come</u> when the bridegroom will be <u>taken away</u> from them; <u>then</u> they will <u>fast</u> in <u>those</u> <u>days</u>.

Acts 1:11: Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This same Jesus, who was **taken** up from you into heaven, will so **come** in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven.

- Persecution
- Lawlessness abound
- Love of many grow cold

Luke 21:28: Now when these things **begin** to happen, **look up** and lift up your heads, because your redemption draws near.

Matthew 24:6: And you will hear of <u>wars and rumors of</u> <u>wars</u>. See that you are not <u>troubled</u>; for all these things must come to pass, but the <u>end is not yet</u>.
