ALIVE: YOU FOLLOW ME!

John 21:18-25

John 21:15: So when they had eaten breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon, son of Jonah, do you love (agape) Me more than these?" He said to Him, "Yes, Lord; You know that I love (phileo) You." He said to him, "Feed My lambs."

John 21:16: He said to him again a second time, "Simon, <u>son of Jonah</u>, do you <u>love (agape)</u> Me?" He said to Him, "Yes, Lord; You know <u>I love (phileo) You</u>." He said to him, "Tend My sheep."

John 21:17: He said to him the third time, "Simon, son of Jonah, do you <u>love</u> (<u>phileo</u>) Me?" Peter was <u>grieved</u> because He said to him the <u>third time</u>, "Do you love Me?" And he said to Him, "Lord, <u>You know all things</u>; You know that I <u>love</u> (<u>phileo</u>) You. Jesus said to him, "<u>Feed My sheep</u>." ["feed" occurs twice]

John 21:18: Most assuredly, I say to you, when you were younger, you girded yourself and walked where you wished; but when you are old, you will <u>stretch</u> <u>out your hands</u>, and another will gird you and carry you where you do not wish.

Peter's death occurred around 67 A.D.

Peter did love Jesus with an agape love - total commitment!

John 21:19: This He spoke, signifying by what <u>death</u> he would <u>glorify</u> God. And when He had spoken this, He said to him, "<u>Follow Me</u>."

Matthew 4:19: Follow Me and I will make you fishers of men.

Restoration (to ministry) involved two responses:

- Love Me
- Follow Me

Peter would die for Jesus as a martyr. What changed for Peter from Denier to Martyr?

Acts 1:8: But you shall receive <u>power</u> when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be <u>witnesses</u> to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

John 21:20-21: Then Peter, turning around, saw <u>the disciple whom Jesus loved</u> <u>following</u>, who also had <u>leaned on His breast</u> at the supper, and said, "Lord, who is the one who betrays You?" Peter, seeing him, said to Jesus, "But Lord, <u>what about this man?"</u>

John 21:22: Jesus said to him, "If I will that he remain <u>till I come</u>, <u>what is that to you? You follow Me</u>." (2x)

Jesus is coming again! He wants His church living like He is coming (John 14).

- Priorities
- Purity
- Urgency

What is that to you? You follow Me! (Don't get your eyes on other people!)

Hebrews 12:1-3: Let us run with <u>endurance</u> the race that is set before us, <u>fixing</u> <u>your eyes on Jesus</u>, the author and finisher of our faith...For <u>consider</u> Him who <u>endured</u> such hostility from sinners against Himself, lest you become <u>weary</u> and <u>discouraged</u> in your souls.

John 21:23: Then this saying went out among the brethren that this disciple would not die. Yet Jesus did not say to him that he would not die, but, "If I will that he remain till I come, what is that to you?"

It was important for John to clarify that Jesus was making a hypothetical statement, so the gospel wouldn't lose credibility after his death.

John 21:24: This is the disciple who <u>testifies</u> of these things, and wrote these things; and \underline{we} know that his testimony is \underline{true} .

1 John 1:1-4 - These things are written that your joy might be full!

John 21:25: And there are also <u>many other things that Jesus did</u>, which if they were written one by one, I suppose that even the <u>world itself could not contain the books</u> that would be written. Amen.

John was selective (exhaustive) in what he wrote.

John 20:30-31: And truly Jesus did <u>many other signs</u> in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; but <u>these are written</u> that you may <u>believe</u> that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have <u>life</u> in His name.
