Personal Spontaneous Worship Luke 1:46-56

Song is the believers natural **response** to God!

Psalm 40:2-3: He brought me up out of a horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and established my steps. He has put a new **song** in my mouth - **praise to our God**; many will see it and fear, and will trust in the Lord.

Ephesians 5:18-19: And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, speaking to one another in **psalms** and **hymns** and **spiritual songs**, **singing** and **making melody in your heart to the Lord.**

Colossians 3:16: Let the <u>word of Christ</u> dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in <u>psalms</u> and <u>hymns</u> and <u>spiritual songs</u>, <u>singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord</u>.

Mary's Personal Spontaneous Worship

Luke 1:46: And Mary said: "My soul magnifies the Lord,"

Luke 1:47: "And my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior."

Body, Soul, and Spirit

Luke 1:47: "And my spirit has rejoiced in **God my Savior**."

Only **sinners** need a **Savior**.

Luke 1:48: "For He has regarded the **lowly state** of His **maidservant**; for behold, henceforth **all generations** will call me **blessed**."

What an **example** Mary is to **all generations**!

- Mary was a <u>virgin</u> until she was married to Joseph.
- Mary was immersed in scripture as a young woman.
- Mary was very <u>humble</u> recognizing her (<u>lowly</u> <u>state</u>).
- Mary was the **maidservant** of the Lord.
- Mary was a worshipper!
- Whatever <u>He says</u> to you, <u>do it</u>. (John 2:6)

Luke 1:49: "For He who is <u>mighty</u> has done <u>great things</u> for me, and <u>holy</u> is His name."

Luke 1:50: "And His <u>mercy</u> is on those who <u>fear</u> Him from <u>generation</u> to <u>generation</u>."

Luke 1:51: "He has shown <u>strength</u> with His <u>arm</u>; He has <u>scattered</u> the <u>proud</u> in the <u>imagination</u> of their hearts."

Luke 1:52: "He has **put down** the **mighty** from their **thrones**, and **exalted the lowly**."

Luke 1:53: "He has <u>filled</u> the <u>hungry</u> with <u>good things</u>, and the <u>rich</u> He has sent away <u>empty</u>."

Luke 1:54: "He has <u>helped</u> His servant Israel, in remembrance of His <u>mercy</u>,"

Luke 1:55: "As He spoke to our fathers, to Abraham and to his **seed** forever."

Luke 1:56: And Mary remained with <u>her</u> about three months, and returned to her house.
