## A Suffering Church Revelation 2:8-11

Revelation 2:8: And to the <u>angel</u> of the church in <u>Smyrna</u>.

Revelation 2:8: And to the angel of the church in Smyrna write, these things says the <u>First and the Last</u> (Isaiah 41:4, 44:6), <u>who was dead</u>, and <u>came to life</u>.

Revelation 2:9: "I <u>know</u> your <u>works</u>, <u>tribulation</u>, and <u>poverty</u> (but you are <u>rich</u>); and I know the <u>blasphemy</u> of those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a <u>synagogue of Satan</u>."

The word here <u>know</u> speaks of <u>complete</u> and <u>full</u> <u>knowledge.</u>

- Works
- <u>Tribulation</u> to <u>break</u>, <u>crush</u>, <u>press</u>, <u>compress</u>, <u>squeeze</u>
- <u>Poverty</u> (but you are <u>rich</u>)

2 Corinthians 8:9: For you know the <u>grace</u> of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was <u>rich</u>, yet for <u>your sakes</u>

He became <u>poor</u>, that you through His <u>poverty</u> might become <u>rich</u>.

1 Timothy 6:17: <u>Command</u> those who are <u>rich</u> in this <u>present age</u> not to be <u>haughty</u>, nor to <u>trust</u> in <u>uncertain riches</u> but in the <u>living God</u>, who <u>gives us richly all things to enjoy</u>. Let them <u>do good</u>, that they be <u>rich</u> in <u>good works</u>, <u>ready to give</u>, <u>willing to share</u>, <u>storing up for themselves a good foundation</u> for <u>the time to come</u>, that they may <u>lay hold on eternal life</u>.

Revelation 2:9: "I <u>know</u> your <u>works</u>, <u>tribulation</u>, and <u>poverty</u> (but you are rich); and I <u>know</u> the <u>blasphemy</u> of those who say they are <u>Jews</u> and are <u>not</u>, but are a <u>synagogue of Satan</u>."

Revelation 2:10: <u>Do not fear</u> (stop being afraid) any of those things which you are about to <u>suffer</u>. Indeed, the <u>devil</u> is about to throw some of you into <u>prison</u>, that you may be <u>tested</u>, and you will have <u>tribulation ten days</u>. <u>Be faithful until death</u>, and I will give you the <u>crown</u> of <u>life</u>.

1 Peter 4:19: Therefore, let those who <u>suffer</u> according to the <u>will of God</u> commit their souls to Him in <u>doing good</u>, as to a <u>faithful creator</u>.

1 Peter 1:6-7: In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, that the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

Hebrews 10:32-39: But recall the former days in which, after you were illuminated, you endured a great struggle with sufferings: partly while you were made a spectacle both by reproaches and tribulations, and partly while you became companions of those who were so treated; for you had <u>compassion</u> on me in my chains, and <u>joyfully</u> accepted the <u>plundering</u> of your goods, knowing that you have a better and an enduring possession for yourselves in <u>heaven</u>. Therefore, do not <u>cast</u> <u>away</u> your <u>confidence</u>, which has great reward. For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise: "For yet a little while, and He who is coming will come and will not tarry. Now the just shall live by faith; But if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him." But we are not of those who draw back to perdition, but of those who believe to the saving of the soul.

Revelation 2:10: <u>Do not fear</u> (stop being afraid) any of those things which you are about to <u>suffer</u>. Indeed, the <u>devil</u> is about to throw some of you into <u>prison</u>, that you may be <u>tested</u>, and you will have <u>tribulation ten days</u>. <u>Be faithful</u> until <u>death</u>, and I will give you the <u>crown</u> of <u>life</u>.

Revelation 2:11: <u>He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches</u> (pl. broader implications). He who <u>overcomes</u> shall not be hurt by the <u>second death</u>.

Revelation 20:11: Then I saw a great white throne and I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books. This is the second death. And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.
