In Danger Of Being Stoned Luke 20:1-19

Luke 20:1: Now it happened on **one** of **those days**, as He **taught** the people in the **temple** and **preached the gospel**.

- The temple was now **cleansed**.
- **Prayer** in the temple was **restored**.
- Jesus was **teaching daily** in the temple.
- All the people are very attentive to hear Him.
- Jesus preached the **gospel**.

Mark 1:15: The <u>time is fulfilled</u>, the <u>kingdom of God is</u> <u>at hand</u>. <u>Repent</u>, and <u>believe</u> in the <u>gospel</u>.

Mark 16:15-16: <u>Go</u> into all the <u>world</u> and preach the <u>gospel</u> to every <u>creature</u>. He who <u>believes</u> and is <u>baptized</u> will be <u>saved</u>; but he who does not <u>believe</u> will be <u>condemned</u>.

Romans 1:16: For I am <u>not ashamed</u> of the <u>gospel</u> of Christ, for it is the <u>power of God</u> to <u>salvation</u> for <u>everyone</u> who <u>believes</u>.

Luke 20:1-2: Now it happened on one of those days, as He taught the people in the temple and preached the gospel that the chief priests and the scribes, together with the elders, confronted Him and spoke to Him, saying, "Tell us, by what authority are You doing these things? Or who is he who gave You this authority?"

Luke 20:3-4: But He answered and said to them, "I also will ask you one thing, and answer Me: **the baptism of John** - was it from **heaven** or from **men**?"

Luke 20:5-8: And they reasoned among themselves, saying, "If we say, 'From heaven, 'He will say, 'Why then did you not believe him?' But if we say, 'From men,' all the people will stone us, for they are persuaded that John was a prophet." So they answered that they did not know where it was from. And Jesus said to them, "Neither will I tell you by what authority I do these things."

Luke 1:15-17: He will also be <u>filled with the Holy Spirit</u>, even from his mother's <u>womb</u>. And he will <u>turn</u> many of the children of Israel to the Lord their God. He will also go before Him in the spirit and power of Elijah, 'to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children,' and the <u>disobedient</u> to the <u>wisdom of the just</u>, to <u>make ready a people prepared for the Lord</u>.

John 1:35: He was the **burning** and **shining lamp**, and you were willing for a time to **rejoice in his light**.

The Parable of the Wicked Vinedressers

Luke 20:9-15: Then He began to tell the people this parable: "A certain man (owner - God) planted a vineyard, leased it to vinedressers (farmers - Jewish leaders), and went into a far country for a long time. Now at vintage-time (grape harvest) he sent a servant to the vinedressers, that they might give him some of the **fruit** of the vineyard. But the vinedressers beat him and sent him away empty-handed. Again he sent another servant; and they beat him also, treated him shamefully, and sent him away empty-handed. And again he sent a third; and they wounded him also and cast him out. Then the owner of the vineyard said, 'What shall I do? I will send my **beloved son** (Jesus). Probably they will respect him when they see him.' But when the vinedressers saw him, they reasoned among themselves, saying, 'This is the heir. Come, let us **kill him**, that the **inheritance may be ours**.' So they cast him **out of the vineyard** and **killed him**. Therefore what will the **owner** of the vineyard do to them?"

Luke 20:16: He will **come** and **destroy** those **vinedressers** (70 AD) and **give** the **vineyard** to **others**. And when they heard it they said, "**Certainly not**! (**May it never be!**)"

Luke 20:17: Then He looked at them and said, "What then is this that is **written**: The **stone** which the **builders rejected**."

Luke 20:18: Whoever falls on that stone will be broken; but on whomever it falls, it will grind him to powder.

Luke 20:19: The chief priests and the scribes that very hour sought to lay hands on Him, but they feared the people - for **they knew He had spoken this parable against them**.

Matthew 21:41-42: He will destroy those wicked men miserably, and lease his vineyard to other vinedressers who will render to him the <u>fruits</u> in <u>their seasons</u>. Jesus said to them, "<u>Have you never read in the Scriptures</u>: The <u>stone</u> which the <u>builders rejected</u> has become the <u>chief cornerstone</u>. This was the Lord's doing, and it is <u>marvelous in our eyes</u>?"

Matthew 21:43: Therefore I say to you, the kingdom of God will be <u>taken</u> from <u>you</u> and given to <u>a nation</u> bearing the <u>fruits</u> of it.

1 Peter 2:9: But you are a <u>chosen generation</u>, a <u>royal</u> <u>priesthood</u>, a <u>holy nation</u>, <u>His own special people</u>, that you may proclaim the <u>praises</u> of Him who called you <u>out</u> <u>of darkness</u> into His <u>marvelous light</u>.

John 15:5: I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears **much fruit.**

- Fruit of Spirit (Galatians 5:22)
- Good works (Colossians 1:10)
- Financial giving (Philippians 4:17)
- Holiness (Romans 6:22)
- Praise, fruit of our lips (Hebrews 13:15)
- Leading others to Jesus (John 4:36)

Matthew 21:43: Therefore I say to you, the kingdom of God will be <u>taken</u> from <u>you</u> and given to <u>a nation</u> bearing the <u>fruits</u> of it.

Romans 11:25-27: For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel <u>until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in</u>. And so all <u>Israel will be saved</u>, as it is written: The Deliverer will come out of Zion, and He will <u>turn away ungodliness from Jacob</u>; for this is My covenant with them, then <u>I take away their sins.</u>

Ezekiel 36:24-27: For I will take you from among the nations, gather you out of all countries, and bring you into your own land (170 verses). Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a tender and responsive heart. I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them.



Matthew 21:43: Therefore I say to you, the kingdom of God will be <u>taken</u> from <u>you</u> and given to <u>a nation</u> bearing the <u>fruits</u> of it. And <u>whoever</u> falls on this <u>stone</u> will be <u>broken</u>; but on <u>whomever it falls</u>, it will <u>grind</u> him to <u>powder</u>.
