
## Worship Before The Throne Revelation 4:6-11



**Revelation 4:6:** Before the <u>throne</u> there was a <u>sea of glass</u>, like <u>crystal</u>. And in the midst of the throne, and around the throne, were <u>four living creatures full of eyes</u> in <u>front</u> and in <u>back</u>.

**Psalm 80:1:** Give ear, O <u>Shepherd</u> of Israel, You who lead Joseph like a flock; You who dwell between the <u>cherubim</u>, shine forth!

**Psalm 99:1:** The Lord reigns; Let the peoples <u>tremble!</u> He dwells between the <u>cherubim</u>; Let the earth be <u>moved!</u>

In **Isaiah 6:2**, these living creatures are called <u>seraphim</u>.

**Revelation 4:7:** The first living creature was like a <u>lion</u>, the second living creature like a <u>calf</u>, the third living creature had a face like a <u>man</u>, and the fourth living creature was like a flying <u>eagle</u>.

**Lion** - The **king** of all the animal kingdom (**Matthew**)

Calf/Ox - Servitude and sacrifice (Mark)

Man - The son of man (Luke)

Eagle - The son of God, reigning in heaven (John)

Together they are a picture of ALL CREATION praising God!

Revelation 4:8: The <u>four living creatures</u>, each having <u>six</u> <u>wings</u>, were <u>full of eyes around</u> and <u>within</u>. And they do not rest <u>day</u> or <u>night</u>, saying: "<u>Holy</u>, <u>Holy</u>, <u>Holy</u>, Lord God <u>Almighty</u>, <u>Who was and is and is to come!"</u>

Jeremiah 32:17: Ah, Lord God! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your <u>great power</u> and outstretched arm. <u>There is nothing too hard for You</u>.

Jeremiah 32:27: "Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh. Is there anything too hard for Me?"

Revelation 4:9: Whenever the <u>living creatures</u> give glory and <u>honor</u> and <u>thanks</u> to Him who <u>sits on the throne</u>, who <u>lives forever and ever</u>...

Psalm 29:2: <u>Give</u> unto the Lord the <u>glory</u> due to His name; <u>Worship</u> (bow) the Lord in the <u>beauty</u> of <u>holiness</u>.

1 Chronicles 16:29: <u>Give</u> to the Lord the <u>glory</u> due His name; <u>Bring</u> an <u>offering</u>, and <u>come before Him</u>. Oh, <u>worship</u> (bow) the Lord in the <u>beauty</u> of <u>holiness</u>!

Is My **glory** safe with **You**?

Glory - acknowledging His splendor, majesty, greatness

Honor - acknowledging His great value and worth

Thanks - a deep thankfulness and gratitude!

**Revelation 4:10:** ...the <u>twenty-four elders</u> fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever...

Who are these 24 elders?

Revelation 4:4: <u>Around the throne</u> were (1) <u>twenty-four thrones</u>, and on the thrones I saw (2) <u>twenty-four elders</u> (3) <u>sitting</u>, (4) <u>clothed in white robes</u>; and they had (5) <u>crowns</u> of gold on their heads.

Revelation 5:9-10: And they <u>sang a new song</u>, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; For <u>You were slain</u>, and have <u>redeemed us</u> to God by <u>Your blood</u> out of <u>every tribe</u> and <u>tongue</u> and <u>people</u> and <u>nation</u>, And have made <u>us kings</u> and <u>priests</u> to our God; And <u>we</u> shall <u>reign on the earth</u>."

Revelation 4:10: The <u>twenty-four elders fall down</u> before <u>Him who sits on the throne</u> and <u>worship</u> Him who lives forever and ever, and <u>cast their crowns before the throne</u>, saying:

**Revelation 4:11:** "You are <u>worthy</u>, O Lord, to receive <u>glory</u> and <u>honor</u> and <u>power</u>; For <u>You created all things</u>, and for <u>your pleasure</u> they are and were created."

Psalm 22:3: God is <u>enthroned</u> in the <u>praises</u> of <u>Israel</u>.
