

The Greatest Revival The World Has Ever Seen

Revelation 14:6-7

In the book of Revelation we read of a coming revival, the greatest revival the earth has ever seen!

1. Ch. 7, 14:1-5: It starts with 144,000 Jewish evangelists
 - a. Saved (redeemed, without fault before the Throne)
 - b. Servants of God
 - c. Sealed
 - d. Song
 - e. Sexually pure
 - f. Speak truth (The firstfruits of the Jewish people; their witness leads to an innumerable number saved, a worldwide revival.)

2. Ch. 11: Two Witnesses
 - a. Two witnesses empowered by the Holy Spirit
 - b. Prophecy (heart of God) from Jerusalem.
 - c. Nobody can harm them until their testimony is finished
 - d. Men began to fear and give glory to God

3. Ch. 12:11: Tribulation saints overcame the Dragon
 - a. The blood of the Lamb
 - b. The word of their testimony
 - c. They did not love their lives unto death

4. Ch.14: An angel preaches the gospel to all the earth

Revelation 14:6: Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven (mid sky), having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth - to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people.

Mark 16:15-16: Go (going and intentional) into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.

Romans 10:13: For whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Romans 10:14-15: How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, who bring glad tidings of good things!"

What happens to those who, have never heard the gospel?

1. God is a Just Judge
2. Unbalanced view of Gods sovereignty
3. The nations are perishing

Who is God?

1 Timothy 2:4: God desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

2 Peter 3:9: The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

Revelation 14:7: saying with a loud voice, "Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come;"

Job 28:28: The fear of the Lord is beginning of wisdom and to depart from evil is understanding.

Matthew 10:28: And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

Romans 3:18: ...there is no fear of God before their eyes.

Revelation 14:7: saying with a loud voice, "Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water."

Romans 1

Daniel 5:22-23: Belshazzar, you have not humbled your heart. You have lifted yourself up against the Lord of heaven; you have praised the gods of silver and gold, bronze and iron, wood and stone, which do not see or hear or know; and the God who holds your breath in His hand and owns all your ways, you have not glorified.

Philippians 2: Salvation or Condemnation
