

The Rise of the Antichrist Revelation 13:1-10

In **Revelation 13**, we read not only of the counterfeit Messiah, but we read of a counterfeit — Trinity!

2 Thessalonians 2:9-10: The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

Revelation 6:1-3: "...Come and see." And I looked, and behold, a white horse. He who sat on it had a bow; and a crown (Grk - stephanos) was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer.

Revelation 13:1: Then I stood on the sand of the sea. And I saw a beast rising up out of the sea (**11:7**), having seven heads (intelligent) and ten horns, (powerful) and on his horns ten crowns, (reign- Daniel 2, 7- Revelation 17) and on his heads a blasphemous name.

Revelation 13:2: Now the beast which I saw was like a leopard, his feet were like the feet of a bear, and his mouth like the mouth of a lion. The dragon gave him his power, his throne, and great authority.

Luke 4:5-7: Then the devil, taking Him up on a high mountain, showed Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. And the devil said to Him, "All this authority I will give You, and their glory; for this has been delivered to me, and I give it to whomever I wish. Therefore, if You will worship before me, all will be Yours."

Revelation 13:3: And I saw one of his heads as if it had been mortally wounded (death), and his deadly wound was healed. And all the world marveled and followed the beast.

Revelation 13:4: So they worshiped the dragon who gave authority to the beast; and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast? Who is able to make war with him?"

Revelation 13:5: And he was given a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies, and he was given authority to continue for forty-two months. (3.5 years- Daniel 9)

Revelation 13:6: Then he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme His name, His tabernacle, and those who dwell in heaven.

Revelation 13:7: It was granted to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them. (Revelation 7 and 13:15) And authority was given him over every tribe, tongue, and nation.

Revelation 13:8: All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

Revelation 13:9: If anyone has an ear, let him hear.

Revelation 13:10: He who leads into captivity shall go into captivity; he who kills with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints.
