Hal was born in Harrisonburg, Virginia on August 23rd, 1931 to Percy Spitzer Rhodes and Mary Clay Arey Rhodes. He attended Harrisonburg schools and received a degree in Chemistry and Physics from James Madison University. He was drafted into the United States Army, he served 3 years, graduating from Ranger school and OCS training. On returning from duty, Hal married his college sweetheart Myra Ann Smith on July 20th, 1957. They have 2 daughters Marcia Arey Rhodes and Amy Leigh Rhodes. Hal worked for Texaco as a Research Chemist for 37 years. In 1976 Texaco transferred him and the family to Beaumont, Texas. While in Florida they volunteered for the state park system giving over 15,000 hours of service between the two of them.
