SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

- What do we learn seeing Jesus entrance into Jerusalem in triumph?
- How does the attitude of the crowd in Jerusalem change between Jesus' entrance and his crucifixion? Why did their attitude change so significantly?
- How did Jesus prepare for his death?
- How do we see Jesus sheltering in the sovereignty of God? How does it look to apply this in your own life?
- What does darkness during the crucifixion communicate to those?
- Why is the tearing of the curtain separating the people from the Most Holy Place so important in understanding the effect of the crucifixion of Jesus?
- What attitude did Jesus need to have in respect to God to place his life into His hands? How does it look in our lives to trust God so completely that our lives are resting in His hands?
- Acknowledging the trustworthiness of God, in His mercy, allowed Jesus to die in victory just as he had lived in victory. Do you acknowledge God in this way? What effect does this acknowledgement have on your life?
