

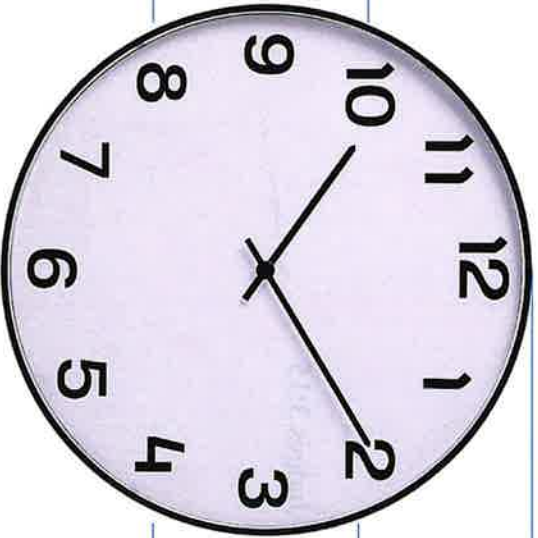

I. The Cycle of the Judges – ch. 2:10-19

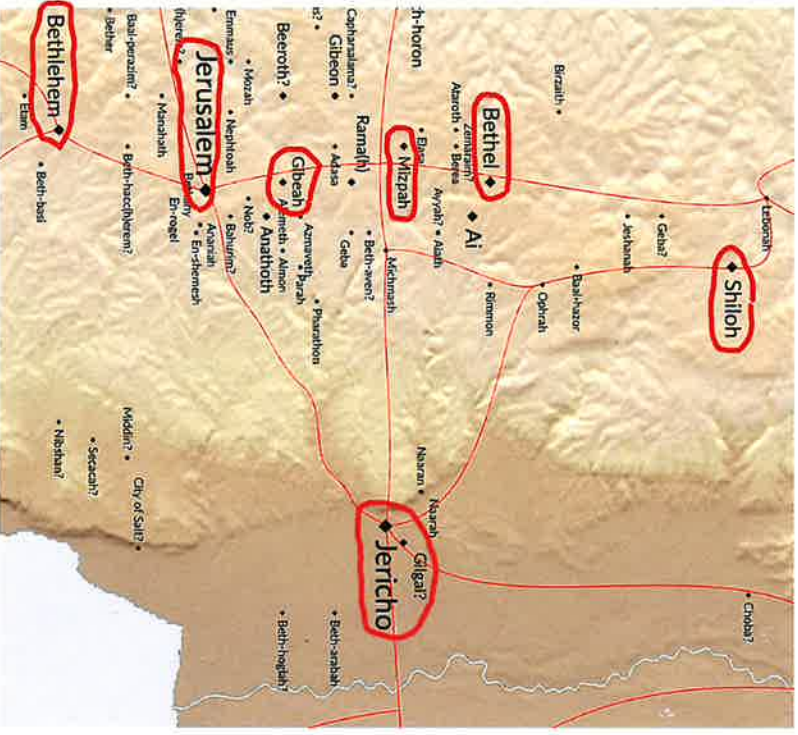


II. Context
