SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

- In the historical context of John's letter, Roman wills were sealed with seven seals. This scroll in verse 1 is the title deed to creation. Only the heir is worthy to open the scroll and the heir of all creation is Jesus. What are the ways that Jesus is described in our verses today?
- What was the significance of each title to John's audience? The Lion of Judah, the Root of David, a Lamb?
- Why would John have wept if no one was found worthy to open the scroll?
- Why can we rejoice in light of the truth that Jesus was worthy to open the scroll?
- How did Jesus prove he was worthy to open the scroll?
- Jesus redeemed the world from sin, death, and Satan purchasing the world back through his death and blood. In his resurrection he now reigns in glory. How does John describe those who were redeemed by the lamb in verse 10?
- For those who are suffering deep persecution, how do you think they'd respond by hearing the truth of verse 10? How does it effect you to know the ultimate truth of verse 10 in your own life?
