UPWARDS – Growing in Our Relationship with God

1. The word “redemption” in verse 7 refers to buying a slave out of slavery or paying the price to free a slave. What were you bought out of? What did God buy for you and what currency did he use?
2. How is the measuring out of God’s grace described and what does that mean to you?
3. Why is it significant that redemption is “in Him” (Christ) and not in anything we do?

INWARDS – Growing in Fellowship with One Another

4. How do these verses influence your understanding of the nature of God, and how should being equally redeemed sinners shape the way we relate to one another?
5. What is the significance of the reference to God’s wisdom and understanding?
6. How does Christ’s sacrifice shape the way we bear with one another’s weaknesses?

OUTWARDS – Reaching Those Around Us

7. How do these verses deepen your understanding and appreciation of what God has done for you lately, and how does that shape your view of what He can do for others?
8. How does knowing we were purchased shape how we view people who are far from God?
9. Who in your life needs to hear that forgiveness is secured, costly, and available in Christ?
