June 27, 2021 | Acts 2:42-47

1. Read Acts 2:42-47. What words would you say best describe the atmosphere of this passage?
2. What inspires, excites, and encourages you in this passage? Is there anything in these verses that make you leery, suspicious, or uncomfortable?
3. There seemed to be a balance in the early church between being “in the temple” and “from house to house” (2:46-47). How might this serve as an example for us?
4. Is it important to spend time with a group of recognizable followers of Jesus both in corporate worship (in the temple courts) and in a more intimate setting (from house to house)? Why or why not?
5. What do you personally, naturally, desire most in your church experience; the apostle’s teaching, fellowship, breaking of bread, or prayers? Why?
6. Is there one of these devotions you shy away from? Why do you think this is?
7. How would you describe your experience of the church meeting together on Sunday mornings? Boring, mediocre, engaging?
8. How much of your experience is your responsibly, and is formed by the preparation of your heart for our worship time together?
9. Is the Holy Spirit nudging you to enter into church life, in a way you haven’t before?
