- 3. Jesus began his first major teaching The Sermon on the Mount with what is known as The Beatitudes. As you read through them (Matt. 5:2-12), how do you see each of the Beatitudes in Jesus?
 - Was Jesus poor in spirit?
 - Did Jesus mourn?
 - Was Jesus meek?
 - Did Jesus hunger and thirst after righteousness?
 - · Was Jesus merciful?
 - Did Jesus have a clean heart?
 - Was Jesus making peace?
 - Was Jesus persecuted?
- 4. Storms are inevitable in our lives. They even reveal our foundation. After reading Matt. 7:24-27, answer the following questions:
 - Explain why storms reveal our foundation.
 - Have you ever thought: If I follow Jesus and do everything right, I won't go through any storms? Why or why not?
