UPWARDS – Growing in Our Relationship with God

1. How does this passage shape your understanding of the heart of God toward the lost?
2. How does the initiative Jesus take in Luke 19:1–5 change the way you see God’s character and His mission of reconciliation?
3. What does lostness mean biblically according to Ephesians 2:12–13?

INWARDS – Growing in Fellowship with One Another

4. What does it mean that Jesus “came to seek” the lost (Luke 19:10)? How should that shape our posture toward others?
5. How does remembering our own lostness deepen your worship and gratitude toward God?
6. In Luke 19:6–8, what evidence shows that Zacchaeus experienced genuine repentance?

OUTWARDS – Reaching Those Around Us

7. Why is it important we reflect God’s heart for the lost rather than the crowd’s judgment (Luke 19:7)?
8. In what ways might God be calling you to be a conduit of His grace and mission to those who are spiritually lost?
9. What is one step you can take this week to participate in Jesus’ mission to seek and save the lost?
