- 2. Does this mean that you are never tempted in these ways anymore? Does this mean that you are not dead to sin because of the temptation? Explain your answer.
- 3. What four actions in verse seven communicate how to continue living in Christ?
- 4. What warning is given in verse eight?
- 5. Are there any worldly philosophies you are drawn too? Why?
- 6. What is behind the philosophies that are contrary to the gospel?
- 7. How do verses nine and ten address the dangers in verse 8?
- 8. Circumcision and baptism are the two analogies used in verses eleven and twelve to describe how we are brought to fullness in Christ.
 - a. What things about circumcision illustrate how we are brought to fullness in Christ?
 - b. What things about baptism illustrate how we are brought to fullness in Christ?
- 9. Verses 13-15 describe to us how "you received Christ Jesus as Lord" (v6), and therefore how you continue to live in him. Can you name four things from these verses that Christ accomplished for you on the cross to make you alive to God?
- 10. What can you do this week to pursue being rooted, built up, and strengthened, so that you are overflowing with thankfulness?
