- 2. What does it mean to be "poor in spirit"?
- 3. How does this first beatitude relate to all the others?
- 4. How did poverty of sprit play a part in the beginning of your relationship with God by faith?
- 5. How are you "poor in spirit" now? Or in what way do you currently experience poverty of spirit?
- 6. What is the antithesis of poverty of spirit? Where does our Western culture land on this subject, and how do we see it play out in everyday life?
- 7. What impact does our culture's preoccupation with self-focus have on our own thought life?
- 8. The present tense of the word "is" in verse three indicates that this is not only a promise for the future but a promise for the here and now. Does that seem real to you? In what ways do we begin to experience the kingdom of heaven while we're still here on earth?
- 9. How has the recognition of your own poverty of sprit enhanced your relationship with God?
