- 1. Can you recall a time when you were clearly excluded from a group of people?
- 2. How does Paul correct the church in verse 17?
- 3. In verses 18-21 what do we see was the Corinthian church's behaviour?
- 4. According to verse 19, should the church be a safe place to be wrong?
- 5. How do you feel about being corrected in the church? Is correction something you are prepared to receive?
- 6. In verse 21 Paul addresses the forming of exclusive, private circles. What kind of exclusive circles exist in our church?
- 7. We need to understand scripture in its context. How do verses 27-29 relate to verses 17-22? What do you believe taking the Lord's Supper in an "unworthy manner" means?
- 8. Why is it important to examine ourselves prior to partaking in the Lord's Supper? What would you be looking for?
- 9. After considering Paul's admonition about the Lord's Supper, is there anything you would do differently when meeting around the Lord's Table?
